A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "TEMPORARY USE LEASE AGREEMENT FOR A HOMELESS SAFE ZONE" BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY FLORIDA ("County") AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST ("City"); AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS OR ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City and the County have collaborated over decades to address the issue of safe housing for the homeless population of Key West and Monroe County; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the City, County and the Monroe County Sheriff agreed to a land swap in which the City would provide a parcel of City-owned land at 250 Trumbo Road for the construction of affordable housing units for Sheriff's employees, and the County would provide a portion of County-owned land at the North Stock Island location where the Sheriff's Headquarters and the Detention Center are located, to build a new and permanent Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter (KOTS); and

WHEREAS, the parties find that is necessary to provide a temporary location for a homeless safe zone for approximately two years, during the construction of the permanent KOTS facility on North Stock Island; and

WHEREAS, the attached Temporary Use Lease Agreement for a Homeless Safe Zone will help protect the health, welfare and safety of citizens of Key West and Monroe County at reasonable cost; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Temporary Use Lease Agreement for a Homeless Safe Zone" between the City and County is hereby approved.

Section 2: That necessary budget amendments and/or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
