A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST (CITY) APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,392.61 FOR ADDITIONAL BREAKERS FOR THE AERATION SYSTEM UPGRADES AND ELECTRICAL SWITCHGEAR (SE35042002) AT THE RICHARD A HEYMAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FACILITY, AND AUTHORIZING A TIME EXTENSION OF 120 DAYS UNDER THE CONTRACT AWARDED TO CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, INC. FOR ITB #21-006; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY TRANSFERS AND AMENDMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 21-158 a contract was awarded to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. for Aeration Systems Upgrades and Electrical Switchgear Replacement at the Richard A. Heyman Environmental Protection Facility, in response to ITB #21-006; and

WHEREAS, four electrical breakers were not included in the construction drawings, and accordingly, that equipment and related costs were not included in original proposal or contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff is pursuing possible reimbursement for the cost of these essential components through the engineering services vendor responsible to the extent of their omission (receipt of such compensation is not assured at this time); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Change Order in the amount of \$125,392.61 for additional breakers and related tasks, including an up-to 120-day time extension, under the contract awarded to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. (ITB 21-006) in Resolution 21-158, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funds for this change order will be used from Wastewater account #401-3504-535-6500, Project #SE35043003, Purchase Order #094500. The purchase Order will be adjusted from \$2,612,100.00 to \$2,737,492.61. Any necessary budget transfers or amendments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute documents related to this Change Order, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.
