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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED 99-YEAR PUBLIC BENEFIT "LEASE AGREEMENT" BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND THE KEY WEST BOTANICAL GARDEN SOCIETY, INC. D/B/A KEY WEST TROPICAL FOREST AND BOTANICAL GARDEN, A 501(c) 3 EXEMPT ORGANIZATION (LESSOR) FOR THE PARCEL LOCATED AT 5210 COLLEGE ROAD ON STOCK ISLAND; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, a referendum of the electors of the City of Key West, Florida, on the primary election ballot of August 23, 2022, authorized the City of Key West to enter into a 99-year lease for the property located at 5210 College Road exclusively for use as a botanical garden and arboretum, providing public access, public recreation, and wildlife habitat; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-941(c) of the code of ordinances, the City Commission finds that a not-for-profit botanical garden is a public benefit, justifying a lease that is below market rate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Lease Agreement" for a term of 99 years, as authorized by public referendum, between the City of Key West and Key West Botanical Garden Society, Inc., d/b/a Key West Tropical Forest and Botanical Garden, for property located at

5210 College Road, as depicted in "Exhibit A" attached to the Lease
Agreement, is hereby approved.

Commission.
