A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT FEE SCHEDULE BY REDUCING THE BUILDING PERMIT ALLOCATION SYSTEM (BPAS) FEES FOR MULTI-UNIT APPLICATIONS, AND BY REDUCING THE EMERGENCY ORDER EXTENSION REQUEST PROCESSING FEES; PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL FEE ADJUSTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 90-487 (b) of the Code of Ordinances allows the City Commission to establish fees, charges and expenses imposed by the Land Development Regulations by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the adjustment would encourage the development of additional housing by reducing financial barriers; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that an amendment to the Planning Department Fee Schedule, to include the adjustment of certain fee costs, is necessary to ensure that costs associated with implementing the Land Development Regulations reflect the resources required to administer such services;
