IN SUPPORT OF THEIR ONGOING EFFORTS IN "KEY WEST RECOVERS" AND CONTINUED FOOD SUPPORT FOR THE RESIDENTS OF KEY WEST; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS, WITH REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN REIMBURSEMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West finds that Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) continues to present challenges to the health, safety, and welfare of the public;

WHEREAS, the Star of the See Foundation's participation in the "Key West Recovers" program, and by providing ongoing food support for residents of Key West has been of great benefit to the City, and the City Commission finds that it would be reasonable to allocate funding to support the program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission approves an allocation of up to \$150,000.00 to the Star of the Sea Foundation, Inc. support of their efforts in the "Key West Recovers" (from Covid-19) program and for general food distribution support in

response to disaster or emergency for local residents/students/workforce. Section 2: Funds for this expenditure will be from account 001-1900-519-8200. Reimbursement (up to 100%) is anticipated via the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). Any necessary budget amendments or adjustments are hereby authorized. Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
