### Background:

On June 4, 2020, City employee Jean DeJean was operating a city-owned Ford F-250 southbound on Grinnell Street, making a left turn onto eastbound Eaton Street on a green light. Mr. DeJean did not see Plaintiff and her husband who were crossing Eaton Street, northbound. Plaintiff was impacted by the front of the city truck at a very slow speed. Plaintiff was transported to LKMC where she was treated and released. Plaintiff followed up with physicians where she lives in Lawrenceville, GA which included an arthroscopic surgery and subsequent physical therapy to her left shoulder. Plaintiff's medical expenses totaled \$67,831.84. Our driver was issued a citation, which he paid, therefore points were assessed. If this case were to proceed to trial, the city could face a verdict in the range of \$234k, using a 3.5 multiplier for pain and suffering. A mediation was conducted on February 1, 2023. There was a contingent settlement reached for \$70,000.00 with the city paying the \$1,000.00 mediation fee and \$822.00 KWFD bill.

### Options:

1. Decline the proposed settlement. The city will incur further litigation expenses in securing a Compulsory Medical Evaluation, and further trial preparation.
2. Approve the proposed settlement for \$71,822.00, thereby avoiding a cap judgement of \$200,000.00 which is very possible with these facts.

### Recommendation:

Approve the proposed settlement.
