-- William Edward Powell Arrest Narrative:

On October 15, 2022, at approximately 1735 hours, Ofc. Roy was dispatched to The Verizon Store located in Key Plaza, (2900 N. Roosevelt Boulevard). The caller told Key West Dispatch a male is highly intoxicated screaming at an employee inside the store. The caller told Key West Dispatch the male refused to leave the store and then the male knocked over a metal sign and there is possible property damage.

I, Ofc. Lopez had to break from a separate call to respond to the above location and assist Ofc. Roy.

When I was driving towards Key Plaza, Key West Communications advised the male left on foot towards Publix. Key West Communications provided the description of the male, (White male with gray hair, wearing blue shorts, a Key West blue shirt, and wearing sunglasses). Key West Communications advised the caller observed the suspect walking inside Publix. When I parked my patrol vehicle in front of Publix, Sgt. Siracuse was inside the store attempting to locate the suspect.

When I was walking towards the entrance of Publix, I observed a male matching the description. The male appeared as if he just walked out of Publix. On contact with the male, I introduced myself to the male and I instructed him to stop while Ofc. Roy speaks with the caller.

As I began to inform the male the reason why I am instructing him to stop, the male said, "I got mad at that fucking guy in there". I informed the male he is matching the description of the male involved in an incident. The male later identified himself as William Powell, (dob:11/02/1967). William continued saying he got mad. William then told me the salesperson in the store ripped him off. William noticed Sgt. Siracuse's patrol vehicle and Ofc. Haynie's patrol vehicle were parked in the area. William began complaining about having several Officers here for this incident. I informed William that Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Haynie were on their way home as they work the dayshift. I requested William to provide me with his identification and he said he did not have it on him. William continued complaining to Sgt. Siracuse that it does not require to have all these Officers here for this issue. I explained one more time to William that the other two Officers are getting off duty and I am the Officer that just called on duty. However, William did not understand, and he became argumentative. I instructed William to sit down, and he did not sit down. Ofc. Haynie instructed William to sit down and then he sat down.

As I was speaking with William, I smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath.

I wrote William's name and date of birth on my notepad while waiting for Ofc. Roy to finish speaking with the caller. William continued yelling and Ofc. Haney explained him to lower his voice for me to be able to provide Dispatch with his information. Ofc. Haynie listend to what William had to say about his disagreement with Verizon. William continued complaining about having 5 cops here for this reason. However, Ofc. Roy was speaking with the caller, and I was the Officer who had to stay with him. William said, "You aren't my boss mother fucker" and I told him that he is correct, I am not his boss. However, he needs to listen to my instructions. William said, "No" and then he said, "No I'm not". William placed his right hand on the ground and began getting up. I grabbed William's left arm, and I instructed him to stay seated and to place his hands behind his back. William pulled his arm away from me and he stood up. Ofc. Haynie grabbed William's right arm and he was actively pulling his arms away from us. William did not stop pulling his arms away from us. I had to place my leg in front of William's leg in order for him to lose his balance and then escort him to the ground. William got on his knees, and he was still trying to get back up. Ofc. Haynie had to place his knee on William's waist area to stop him from getting back up while I was placing handcuffs on him. We sat William on the ground and then he began asking for a supervisor. Sgt. Siracuse explained

to William that he was there the entire time.

Ofc. Haynie and I walked William to my patrol vehicle. Ofc. Haynie began searching William while I was holding his right arm. William turned his face towards me, and he said, "Go head tough guys" several times as he continued leaning his head towards my face. I instructed William not to get on my face and he said, "Or what". I placed William in the rear passenger side of my patrol vehicle.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

Sgt. Siracuse later did the response to resistance incident.

Based on the facts and evidence, William Powell did resist and oppose to follow my verbal instructions while I was performing my legal duties as a Police Officer. Ofc. Roy was interviewing the caller while I had William detained. William became belligerent and he refused to follow simple verbal instructions by pulling his arms away from us due to his actions. Ofc. Haynie and I were wearing our class B uniform with the Key West Police insignia on our sleeves. Ofc. Haynie and I were recognizable as Police Officers. Contrary to F.S.S. 843.02.

Based on the facts and evidence, William Powell did breach the peace and the sense of public decency with his belligerent behavior. William was instructed to be seated on the side of the road. However, he stood up and when I attempted to place handcuffs on him, he continued actively resisting. William's actions put us on the right lane of traffic affecting the right lane of traffic for the public/residents to use. (It Should be noted there were several vehicles in the area and his actions could have caused an accident with the amount of foot traffic and vehicle traffic at this time of the day). Contrary to F.S.S. 877.03.

On 10.15.22, at approximately 1745 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to 2900 N. Roosevelt Blvd. reference a disorderly subject at the Verizon Wireless store.

Dispatch had advised a white male wearing blue shorts and blue Key West shirt was fighting with Verizon personnel and then began tearing down signage inside the store. We were last advised the male suspect, later identified as William Powell, had walked toward Publix.

Ofc. J. Lopez was first to make contact with Powell in the parking lot. Powell appeared disturbed and slightly under the influence of alcohol and/or narcotics. After several verbal commands to sit down on a nearby curb he finally did. Powell was constantly contesting the number of Officers on scene. While other officers checked with Verizon reference damage and trespassing accusations, Ofc. Lopez attempted to ID Powell and gather information. Prior to the conclusion of our investigation, Powell (who had not produced any physical form of ID), stated he was standing up and leaving and began to do so. Ofc. J. Lopez grabbed his left arm and proceeded to do an arm bar takedown into the parking lot. Ofc. Haynie was also present and assisted by trying to place Powell's right arm behind his back. Powell continued to yell and pull his arms away from the officers.

I knelt across Powell's back and he received verbal commands to sop resisting and place his hands behind his back. Powell was handcuffed and sat up. Officers Lopez, Haynie and I placed Powell into the rear of Officer Lopez's patrol vehicle and secured him with the seatbelt. Powell was yelling during the remainder of our encounter, threatening to sue us for our actions and claiming Verizon employees were scammers.

Powell sustained abrasions to his knees from the takedown. I asked Ofc. Lopez to photograph his injuries and he did so, later providing them to me. I uploaded the photographs into evidence.com.

My BWC video was uploaded under this case number and Powell was arrested for disorderly conduct and resisting arrest.
