On Friday, December 23, 2022, at approximately 2209 hours, I (Ofc Andrade) responded to 222 Duval Street, reference a City Parking Enforcement Officer requiring assistance.

On arrival I met with Christopher Lee Petrie who told me the following:

A white male (later identified as Scott Alan King) on a black bicycle, wearing a yellow rain suit, threw a cup containing a white liquid and frothy substance at his city parking vehicle. This occurred as Petrie, a City of Key West Parking Enforcement Officer was in his uniform and at that location awaiting a wrecker for a vehicle he was having towed for a parking violation.

I left the area in search of King. I located King next to The Half Shell Raw Bar restaurant, 231 Margaret Street. I introduced myself to King and asked him if he was just near Duval Street and he said no, then said he was. I asked if King if he had an encounter with anyone there and he said, "Not at all." I then began to read King his Miranda Rights from a prepared agency card, as is my routine procedure, and King became irate saying he didn't want to hear it. I told him to stop and listen and I continued. King said he did not wish to speak to me after I completed reading Miranda, and I said, "Okay." King then became irate and asked me what this was about, and I asked him if he wished to speak to me or not and King said he did. I explained that I was investigating a crime, further explaining the incident. King said that he knew exactly what I was talking about adding that someone threw whip cream at a vehicle's window, and he walked over to wipe it off. I told him that what I saw was not wiped but splattered. King again denied that he did it. I asked King for his identification which he provided it.

I radioed to Key West Communications Channel One to have Petrie contact me. I spoke with Petrie over the phone and asked for him to come to my location to identify King.

While I was waiting for Petrie, I approached King again and he again told me that he "wiped it off." King continued his account saying, "I saw some idiot do something stupid. This is fucked up you don't do shit like that."

Petrie arrived and I signaled for Petrie to stay in his vehicle. I approached Petrie and asked if King was the individual that threw the substance at his vehicle, and he indicated that it was unmistakably him. As I was talking with Petrie, King began to approach talking aggressively requiring me to have to repeatedly order him to move back until he finally complied.

I walked back to King and asked him to put what he had in his hand on the ground twice. King had a plastic rectangular shaped container that he then smashed on the ground, shattering it, and shouted, "Fuck You!" repeatedly, after which he removed his coat quickly and prostrated himself towards me in a manner which I interpreted as hostile and believing that violence was about to ensue. I quickly unholstered my Taser, turning it on, and pointing it at King. I ordered King to place his hands behind his back at least three times before he complied. King continued yelling obscenities at me. I ordered King to his knees, and I attempted to place him in handcuffs. King began to resist my efforts pulling his torso away from me. I ordered King to stop but King continued and tried to pull away from me. I placed King onto his belly at this point, but King continued to resist my efforts trying to keep his hands in front of him.

I was able to secure King in handcuffs and I rolled him onto his left side and sat him up. Sgt Kouri radioed me asking if his presence was needed, and I said yes when I noticed King was bleeding from above his left eye. Ofc Bouvier arrived on scene moments later with PO Moore. I adjusted King's handcuffs and double locked them. King again became belligerent and tensed his body attempting to turn in my direction while I was behind him. K-9 Ofc T. Anglin arrived on scene with PO Golovanov. Ofc Bouvier and I stood King up and walked him to my patrol car. King was yelling obscenities the entire time. I stepped away and asked PO Moore to obtain Petrie's information. PO

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Moore later informed me that Petrie was in vehicle #7303, bearing FL tag XD1359. I then opened the back door of my patrol car and engaged my Axon in-car camera while Ofc Bouvier and K-9 Ofc T. Anglin placed King in the backseat.

Sgt Kouri arrived on scene moments later and spoke with King. Sgt Kouri then spoke with a bystander who witnessed the incident. Sgt Kouri later said that they individual wished to remain anonymous but did state that my actions towards King were not excessive.

Ofc Lopez later arrived on scene and photographed car #7303.

PO Golovanov and I transported King to Lower Key Medical Center where his wound was cleaned and then discharged. King's injury was a minor abrasion, only requiring a small bandage. I photographed King's injury. It should be noted that while at Lower Keys Medical Center King continued with obscenities in the presence of a family with a child.

I then transported King to the Monroe County Detention Center for processing.

Based on the facts and evidence, I have probable cause to believe that Scott Alan King did commit the act of criminal mischief, in violation of FSS 806.13(1)(b)1, by willfully and maliciously through a cup containing a white and frothy liquid at a City of Key West Parking Enforcement Vehicle, #7303, belonging to the City of Key West, while occupied by a City of Key West Parking Enforcement Officer, Christopher Lee Petrie, resulting in \$200 or less in damages.

Scott Alan King committed the act of resisting an officer without violence, in violation of FSS 843.02, by opposing myself, Officer E. Andrade, of the Key West Police Department, while in my Class B duty uniform in the performance of my legal duties, by pulling away from me while I was attempting to place him in handcuffs, tensing his body and taking his arms from behind his back as I ordered him to give me hands and to stop resisting.

Petrie filled out a Sworn Statement which was submitted to the Key West Records Department.

The photographs of the vehicle and King's injury were submitted to Evidence.com.

My BWC was active for this encounter and submitted to Evidence.com.
