As tasked, the Sustainability Advisory Board is responsible for advising on sustainability matters to the City and its Commissioners. The Board recently held our annual priority ranking workshop and places upmost importance on the following actions. Actions that are linked to the Key West Forward Strategic Plan are denoted in the following nomenclature: "KWF: Priority # - Goal # . Action #).

1) Less Cars on the Road

- a) Free and Frequent North Line and Lower Keys Shuttle (KWF: 6-1.1, 6-1.5)
- b) Create Revenue Sources for Transit FY23 (6-1.3)
- c) Continue to Implement Bike Ped Master Plan (KWF: 6-2.1, 6-2.2, 6-2.3, 6-2.4, 6-2.8, 6-2.10)

2) Reduce Waste Stream

- a) Renegotiate/Bid New Solid Waste/Recycling Contract
- b) Continue to Evaluate Mt. Trashmore

3) Adapt and Mitigate for Climate Change

- a) Hire 50% Adaptation Coordinator, 50% Energy Manager (KWF: 2-1.1)
- b) Begin Key West Adaptation Plan (KWF: 2-3.1, 2-3.2)
- c) Address Stormwater (KWF: 2-2.1, 2-2.3)
- d) Increase Environmental Protection (KWF: 4-1.1, 6-2.6, 4-5.5)
