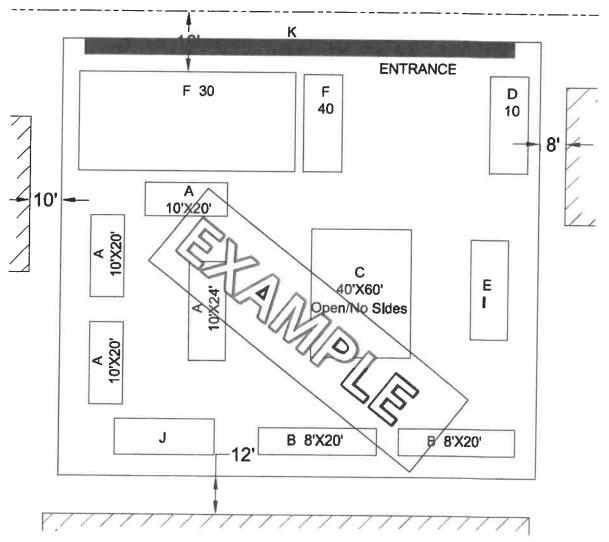

- 6. Ingress/egress by the Event Organizer shall be coordinated with the City of Key West.
- 7. The City property used must be maintained in an orderly and neat condition. City of Key West may request Event Organizer to improve conditions of site within reason if conditions become unacceptable.
- 8. No trash may be left on site. Use of City of Key West dumpsters is not authorized unless prior approval is obtained from the City Manager.
- 9. No alcoholic beverages/non-prescription drugs or food may be brought onto or sold on Truman Waterfront without prior approval from the City Commission.
- 10. No hazardous material or waste shall be used or stored on the premises without submitting a Hazardous Waste Handling and Spill Plan to the City of Key West.





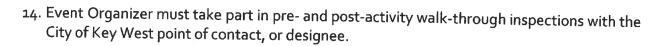

- 12. All trash (including waste oil) and equipment including portable toilets and trailers shall be removed no later than close of business of the last day of the event. Event Organizer should plan accordingly. City of Key West may impose additional fees for use of City Property beyond usage dates.

## INITIALS REQUIRED for Truman Waterfront Property

For Use of Truman Waterfront, the Event Organizer is subject to the following additional provisions:



13. Event Organizer is responsible for obtaining necessary permits required by any other agencies pertaining to this Special Event such as Federal, State, Local, Coast Guard, Navy, Marine Sanctuary, etc. and is responsible for providing proof of permit prior to entering into an agreement with the City of Key West.



- 15. Event Organizer must provide the City of Key West with a detailed schedule for activities.
- 16. City of Key West personnel shall be allowed access to the site at all times.
- 17. Event Organizer shall provide sufficient personnel to ensure proper and safe operation of the activity.
- Event Organizer may not stay overnight on Truman Waterfront without prior approval from the City of Key West.
- 19. Any use of NOAA property or seawall must be coordinated with directly with NOAA.
- 20. Unfettered access to Navy, NOAA and State Park property must be maintained at all time
- 21. Use of the inner basin for any activities is not authorized.

Beds will take off at Petronia, 2 beds at a time. They will stroll down to Southard St, which is where the Race will begin, back to Petronia St.

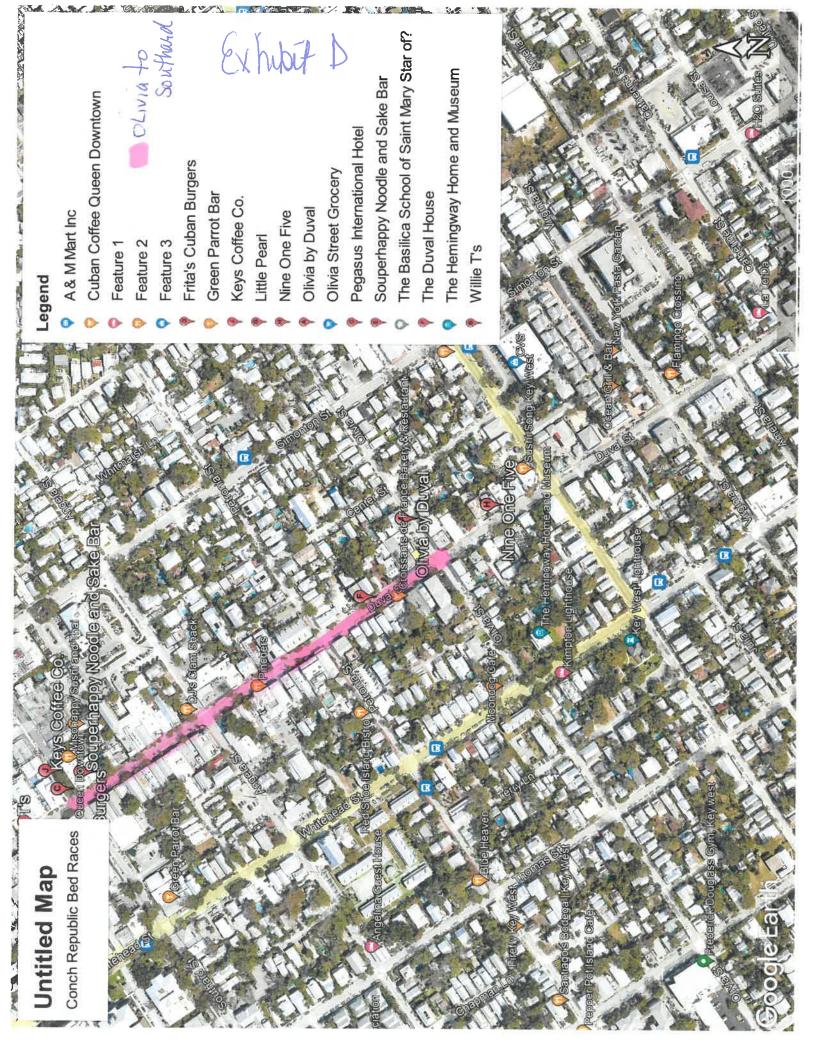
Once the Races are over, an award ceremony will take place on Duval between Petronia & Angela.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF

## **OFF-DUTY KEY WEST POLICE OFFICERS**

Police Officers working special details are employed through the police union at the hourly rate of \$55.00 per hour per officer, with a four hour minimum; four or more officers require one supervisor to be paid at the rate of \$60.00 per hour with a four hour minimum. If, for any reason, there is a change in the scheduled reporting time for police officers, you must contact Lt. Joe Tripp (305) 809-1027 at least twenty-four hours in advance of the scheduled reporting time for police officer(s). Failure to notify Lt. Joe Tripp within the specified time, will obligate you to pay the officer(s) the four hour minimum required by the police union. All officers are normally to be paid the day of the event at the site.

Should the Key West Police Department determine additional security is required, additional officer(s) will be assigned. Costs for any additional officers will be dependent upon the availability of off-duty officers.
