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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVE THE RANKING OF RESPONSES TO THE REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) NO. 22-001 FOR THE KEY WEST COMPREHENSIVE ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM OR TEAM, TETRA TECH, INC.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No.22-001 to identify a vendor to provide a Comprehensive Adaptation and Resilience Implementation Plan that consists of a multi-threat vulnerability assessment and a plan to prioritize and implement climate adaptation measures, as set forth in RFQ No. 22-004; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ outlines the professional services required to complete this project, and requires deliverables including an adaptation plan with vulnerability analysis and ten year budget; and

WHEREAS, Sea Level Rise was identified in the Key West Forward Strategic Plan as the #2 Priority for the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2023, the City Clerk opened vendor submittals, four of which were deemed responsive; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2023, a Selection/Ranking Committee comprised of community members and City staff ranked the four responsive RFQ submittals; and determined Tetra Tech, Inc. to be the highest-ranked proposer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the vendor submittals for RFQ No.22-001 for the Key West Comprehensive Adaptation and Resilience Implementation Plan are hereby ranked by the City Commission as follows:

- (1) Tetra Tech, Inc.
- (2) Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc.
- (3) HALFF
- (4) WGI, Inc.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute a contractual agreement with the top-ranked vendor, Tetra Tech, Inc., in substantial conformance with the RFQ, and as legally permissible pursuant to the City Charter, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
