A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST CULTURAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY, INC. TO CONDUCT A SUNSET CELEBRATION AS A FUNDRAISER ON FRIDAY, MAY 26, 2023, SATURDAY, MAY 27, 2023 AND SUNDAY, MAY 28, 2023 FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 9:30 P.M. DURING THEIR DAILY SUNSET CELEBRATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT MALLORY SQUARE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern. about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That the Key West Cultural Reservation Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the Fundraiser on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED

that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed and that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Inc, will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 6. That the Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
