A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD TO HOLD THE 2023 KEY WEST HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION AT THE KEY WEST TRUMAN WATERFRONT COFFEE BUTLER AMPHITHEATER ON FRIDAY, MAY 26, 2023, FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the Monroe County School Board wishes to conduct the 2023 Key West High School Graduation at the Key West Truman Waterfront Coffee Butler Amphitheater between the hours of 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 26, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That the Monroe County School Board is hereby granted permission to hold the "2023 Key West High School Graduation" on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. the Monroe County School Board will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used that that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
