

RESOLUTION NO. 23-274

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY (20) GETAC B360 LAPTOPS, AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FROM PCN STRATEGIES, PURSUANT TO KEY WEST CODE OF ORDINANCES, SEC. 2-797 (4) (b) - BEST INTEREST AND SEC. 2-844 (a) (b) - BRAND NAME, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$64,724.60; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the purchase of Getac B360 Laptops on a brand name preference to replace equipment that has reached its useful service life and achieve consistency with existing KWPD computer hardware; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-844 provides "Since use of a brand name specification is restrictive of product competition, it may be used only when the purchasing agent makes a written determination that only the identified brand name item will satisfy the city's needs."; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained price quotes from three vendors and determined that PCN Strategies would provide the necessary equipment for the lowest cost; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that the purchase of Getac B360 Laptops from PCN Strategies, for use by the KWPD, as described in the attached price quotes, is in the best interest of the City pursuant to section 2-797 (4) (b) of the Code of Ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY **THE** CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of twenty (20) Getac B360 Laptops, with related equipment and software, for a total amount of \$64,724.60, pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances sections 2-797 (4) (b) and 2-844 (a) (b), in accordance with the quotation from PCN Strategies, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this purchase is funded for FY 23/24 in the police budget account #101-2101-521-6400, Infrastructure Surtax Machinery and Equipment.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
