Subject: LTC - Park N Ride Operational Expenditures FY2013 - FY2023

This Letter to the City Commission (LTC) is to provide updated information regarding the operational expenditures of the City's Park N Ride garage located at 301 Grinnell Street. The City Commission had requested this information during the recent discussion with respect to the Park and Ride.

The Finance Department reviewed direct expenditures of the Park N Ride facility include electricity, elevator and other maintenance, rent payment to Key West Bight, credit card fees, and a parking revenue transfer to the Transportation Alternative Fund since 2013. Indirect expenditures include property insurance allocations, an allocation for general fund support, and an allocation of the transit staff salaries to operate the facility.
