- 2. I have attached the incident report (23-5788) generated by Officer Jorge Mayorga Lopez documenting this incident.
- 3. I have sent a link with the Body Worn Camera (BWC) Videos pertaining to the case.

Based on my research into this incident, I do not believe there to be any violation of KWPD policy or Florida state statute by Officer J. Mayorga Lopez.

Officer J. Mayorga Lopez performed his duties on scene, conducted an investigation into the allegations and used Key West DOT Supervisor R. Hernandez to obtain the identity of Mr. Fisher. Later that week, Officer J. Mayorga Lopez contacted Detective Marcus del Valle regarding the case. Officer J. Mayorga Lopez and Detective M. del Valle contacted Key West City Attorney Ronald Ramsingh to ensure the issuance of a Trespass Warning to Mr. Fisher was acceptable for his actions.

On October 29, 2023, Officer J. Mayorga Lopez was able to speak to Mr. Fisher and issue a Trespass Warning from all City of Key West Buses. Mr. Fisher understood that he could not use any city buses and he would be arrested if he did. (BWC Video)

Officer J. Mayorga Lopez informed the victim, the victim's guardian and KWDOT Director that Mr. Fisher was issued the Trespass Warning.
