-- Jon Pierre Williams Arrest Narrative:

On Sunday, November 5, 2023, at approximately 0711 hours, I (Officer Johnson) responded to Key West Kia (2826 N. Roosevelt Blvd). in reference to two people sleeping in a white car. The caller was the manager for the property, Josh Bottoms. Upon arrival, I saw a white Toyota parked in the handicapped parking space in front of the Kia dealership. There was a black male sleeping in the back seat with the door open and his feet sticking out. There was a black male sleeping in the front seat. I circled the car and conducted a plain view search before attempting to wake them up. I attempted to wake up the person in the back seat first, but he didn't wake up. I decided it was more important to try to wake the person behind the wheel of the car because it was running.

I attempted to wake up the person behind the wheel of the car. He was later identified by his Texas drivers license as Jon Williams. Williams would not wake up. I continued to ask him to wake up and I continued to identify myself as a police officer. I used my un-extended baton to apply a sternum rub technique to attempt to wake him. Williams kept trying to push my arm away. I grabbed Williams by the arms and continued the sternum rub and shake him to wake him up. Williams continued to swat at me with his hands and refused to wake up. I told Williams not to touch me. Eventually Williams woke up fully. I identified myself as a police officer again. Williams said he heard me. I advised him that he was trespassing on private property. I told Williams to provide me with his identification. Williams refused to give me his identification. Williams got out of the car. I ordered Williams to put his hands behind his back. William refused and pushed me out of the way in order to get away. I threatened to taser Williams if he did not comply. I pushed Williams against the car and grabbed his left wrist. Williams twisted his arm around and pulled free. Williams started to walk away. I yelled out the word Taser. I threatened to Taser Williams and ordered him to the ground. Williams continued to walk away. I deployed the Taser. The upper prong pierced the skin in Williams upper back. The lower prong did not make penetration into the skin. I saw the upper prong had penetrated so I deployed the taser again just below the hip line in order to get full neuromuscular incapacitation. The top prong of the second shot entered the skin just below Williams' hip line and the lower probe entered the skin in the left buttock. Williams experienced full neuromuscular incapacitation and fell to the ground. I ordered Williams to his stomach and told him to put his arms behind his back. Williams partially complied. I placed Williams in handcuffs, double locked.

I had rescue respond to inspect and treat Williams. I searched and placed Williams in the back of my patrol car. I read Williams his Miranda rights. Williams waived his rights and wished to talk to me. Williams stated he came to the property to sleep. I explained to Williams why he was arrested. Williams stated that he apologized for what had happened.

Officer Calvert was a back up officer. Sgt. Duponty responded to the scene for the response to resistance incident. Officer Calvert identified the passenger in the car. See Officer Calvert's supplemental report.

I transported Williams to Monroe County Jail without incident. The incident was recorded on my BWC and in car camera. I did not sustain any injuries. I was wearing a Key West Police uniform.

Charges:

Charge #1 Battery of Law enforcement officer FSS. 784.07

The Defendant, Jon Williams, did intentionally touch or strike the victim, Officer M. Johnson, against his will by pushing him out of his way. Officer M. Johnson was a Key West police officer engaged in a lawful duty at the time of the incident. Officer Johnson clearly identified as a police officer and was wearing a Key West Police uniform.

On Sunday, November 5, 2023 Ofc. M. Johnson and I (Ofc. M. Calvert) responded to 2628 N. Roosevelt Blvd, Kia of Key West, in reference to a call from the General Manager Joshua Bottoms that there were trespassers on the property that he wanted removed.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Johnson was already on scene and had approached a white 4-door Toyota that had the driver's side front door and passenger side rear - door open, and was occupied by two black males, who were sleeping inside. I saw another male standing at the back of the property and he identified himself as a reporting party via hand motion and pointed at the car confirming that it was the trespassers. Ofc. Johnson told me they were both asleep, started to try and wake the rear passenger and then made his way over to the driver, to start the attempts to wake him up. I continued to awaken the rear seat passenger. After several verbal attempts and tapping the bottom of the rear passengers feet, he woke up. I told him we were there because they were trespassing on Kia's property. During this time Ofc. Johnson was still unable to awaken the driver, and began sternum rubs to arouse the driver seat occupant. The subject, later identified as Jon Williams by his Texas DL, began putting his arms up and moving them around to resist Ofc. Johnson's efforts. I heard Ofc. Johnson giving loud verbal commands and identifying himself as a Key West Police Officer several times, before he yelled, "don't push me." I was still on the passenger side with the other male, identified by his AL DL as Jamaricq Williams, who was compliant at the time, awake and sitting. I moved to the front passenger side and pulled out my Taser, after I heard Ofc. Johnson's statement and saw Jon actively resisting Ofc. Johnson attempts for compliance. When Jon got out of the car I went to the other side, Ofc. Johnson had his Taser out and powered on, and I put mine away when able. Jon continued to not comply with verbal commands to put his hands behind his back, and pull his arms away from Ofc. Johnson and I, and make pushing/shoving motions to get us away. He did not make physical contact with me. Ofc. Johnson told him to stop and he started to walk away and still not comply with loud, verbal and lawful commands. Ofc. Johnson told him he would be tased, I moved back and Ofc. Johnson shot, with one probe making contact and the other not. Then Ofc. Johnson deployed the second cartridge making full contact and the subject started to fall to the ground next to the passenger side of the vehicle. I kept his head from impacting the ground and was still watching the other subject, Jamaricq, who had not moved from his position in the rear passenger seat.

I advised over Ch 1 that a taser had been deployed.

Sgt. Duponty responded to the scene.

Officers Howell and Roscoe responded to assist further.

Once more officers were on scene I obtained the identification from the rear passenger, who was valid and clear. I

advised him again that we were called by the managers of KIA due to him and his friend trespassing on the property. I explained how it was trespassing and that we were providing simple directions, and it did not need to escalate. Jamaricq did not have any charges and was able to drive the car away back to Marathon Key, where he stated they were currently staying.

All this was recorded on my BWC and my in-car Axon was activated by Ofc. Johnson's Taser, which was facing the direction of where we had the interaction with the two subjects inside the vehicle.

I spoke to a manager of Kia on the scene, Alexander King, who stated to me on BWC that he was jogging and noticed the trespassers and after attempting to wake them himself, he called the GM Josh Bottoms who contacted KWPD Dispatch. King told me he watched everything and stated that Officer Johnson and I gave them many chances to comply with our lawful orders, and he could not believe that the driver (Jon) was still resisting. King also stated Kia has outdoor cameras if needed, and I passed this on to Ofc. Johnson and Sgt. Duponty.
