-- Jesus Perez Arrest Narrative:

On Wednesday, December 13, 2023, at approximately 10:00 PM, I, Ofc. K. Bouvier was dispatched to 815 Duval St. in reference to a call of a burglary.

Upon my arrival, I met with the reporting person and identified him by his Florida license as HARVEY SCOTT DUBOV, DOB 11/27/1961. Mr. Dubov told me when he and his family returned home, they discovered someone had entered their hotel room and stolen several high value items.

Some of the stolen items were two MacBook Pros, one valued at \$6,500, and the other valued at \$1,500, 1 pair of Versace sunglasses, valued at \$600, one pair of Louis Vuitton sunglasses, valued at \$1,000, 1 pair of Versace sneakers valued at \$1,100, three pairs of Nike's sneakers, valued at \$300 each, two Louis Vuitton purses, one valued at \$200 and the other valued at \$2,000, 3 Louis Vuitton shirts, valued at \$300 each, 1 gold necklace valued at \$400, 1 Brazilian passport, and \$400 in cash. There were also several credit cards taken.

Mr. Dubov told me his group left the hotel around 5:00 PM and returned around 9:00 PM. I met with hotel management who was able to show me security footage of what appeared to be a white or Latin male entering the hotel room through a closed, but not locked window. The man in the video was wearing what appeared to be a black hoodie with white stripes going down the sleeves. The man was also wearing shorts and dark colored shoes with light colored soles. The man was also seen carrying a gray backpack.

An image of the burglary suspect was disseminated to all on duty officers. Officers spotted the suspect several times throughout the evening, each time instructing the suspect to stop, each time the suspect ran from officers, eluding detention, and identification.

The image of the suspect was shared with the oncoming shift of officers, one of whom was able to identify the suspect as JESUS PEREZ, DOB 12/01/1999.

At around 7:30 AM on Thursday, December 14, 2023, Officers responded to 418 United St. in reference to a call of a trespasser. When officers arrived, they identified the trespasser as Jesus Perez.

I responded to the scene and met with Mr. Perez. I noticed that Mr. Perez was wearing the same clothes he had on during the burglary, as well as when officers tried to stop him hours ago, however, he did not have the gray backpack with him. I advised Mr. Perez of the Miranda Warning and he agreed to speak to me without an attorney present. Mr. Perez told me he didn't remember anything he did last night because he was drunk.

Search incident to arrest, I found the victim's stolen credit cards, as well as U.S., and Brazilian currency in his wallet. When I asked Mr. Perez how the items stolen in the burglary ended up in his wallet, he told me that he didn't know what I was talking about. I also located two pairs of the stolen sunglasses in Mr. Perez's bag.

I also noticed that Mr. Perez had one Taser prong stuck in his clothing from the officer's attempts to tase him while he was fleeing.

Based on the physical evidence, video surveillance and first-hand accounts of law enforcement officers, I believed probable cause existed that JESUS PEREZ, DOB 12/01/1999 did violate Florida Statute 810.02(3)(B)-BURGLARY OF AN UNOCCUPIED DWELLING and Florida Statute 812.014 (2)(C)(3)-GRAND THEFT 10K LESS THAN

I transported Mr. Perez to Lower Keys Medical Center for clearance. Once cleared by medical staff, I transported Mr. Perez to the Monroe County Detention Center. While at the jail I noticed Mr. Perez maneuvered his handcuffs to the front of his body. I requested Ofc. T. Haynie assist me with placing the handcuffs behind Mr. Perez. After the handcuffs were placed behind Mr. Perez, I began to walk him from the sallyport to the jail elevator, when Mr. Perez jerked his arm away from me in an attempt to stop me from escorting him to the jail elevator. When I attempted to regain control of Mr. Perez he continued to jerk, tense, and pull away from me. After it became clear Mr. Perez was not going to calm down, I redirected Mr. Perez to the ground until I was able to gain his compliance. After a short time, Mr. Perez was turned over to detention staff without further incident.

On Thursday, December 14, 2023, around 9:00 AM, I was in the sally-port of the jail at 5501 College Road. I was getting ready to escort an arrestee to the intake area at the jail.

Officer Bouvier was also at the jail with an arrestee, Jesus Perez, in relation to this case number. Jesus was under arrest for a burglary case that happened over night.

Officer Bouvier asked for my assistance as Jesus slipped his handcuffs. I remembered that Jesus was initially handcuffed behind the back. I observed that his handcuffs were now in the front. I assisted Officer Bouvier with maneuvering Jesus` hands behind his back and resecuring the handcuffs.

Officer Bouvier then began escorting Jesus to the elevator. Jesus began to swing his body around causing Officer Bouvier to do a takedown maneuver to gain control of Jesus. I assisted Officer Bouvier with holding Jesus's legs down.

I learned that Officer Bouvier sustained an injury to his hand and was at a local Urgent Care center. I completed this arrest affidavit, charging Jesus for violating following Florida State Statute:

Jesus did violate F.S.S. 843.02, RESIST/OBSTRUCT OFFICER W/O VIOLENCE by tensing his body and pulling away while being escorted to the sally-port elevator by Officer Bouvier. Officer Bouvier was a Key West Police Officer legally executing his duties. I bore witness to the violation.

Officer Bouvier will follow up with more charges in relation to this case.

I activated my bodycam during this call.

On Wednesday, December 13, 2023 at approximately 2345 hours I, Ofc. J. Hesse, was in the area of Kennedy Dr and Boog Powell Ct. While PO L. Roman operated our marked patrol vehicle, I observed a male subject matching the description of a burglary suspect, occurring earlier that evening at 815 Duval St. See Ofc. Bouiver's case report for greater details.

While traveling southbound on Kennedy Dr I observed the male, later identified as Jesus Perez, walking northbound on the sidewalk to the east of the roadway. Perez was observed to be wearing black shorts, a black sweatshirt with white stripes on the shoulders, and a grey backpack. The clothing was the same as a photo of the subject earlier obtained from video surveillance at the location. Probable cause for felony burglary existed for the arrest of Perez at the time of contact.

PO Roman immediately stopped the vehicle and I exited the passenger side. I proceeded behind the vehicle at which time I observed Perez begin running away from me, eastbound on Boog Powell Ct. I loudly identified myself as an Officer, ordered him to stop, and told him he was under arrest. Perez did not comply with commands and continued fleeing law enforcement. Due to Perez's distance from me, I did not continue to pursue him on foot and pursuit with a vehicle was not possible due to physical barriers.

I observed Perez run to 14th St and turn right (southbound) before losing sight of him. All activity was broadcast over Channel 1 to other responding Officers as the activity was occurring. Multiple Officers arrived in the area a short time later, which was thoroughly searched, however Perez was unable to be located at that time.

In addition to previous probable cause for Perez's arrest, I additionally had probable cause to arrest Perez for the crime of resisting arrest for obstructing an officer in the execution of legal duties.

Later in the shift, at approximately 0338 hours on 12/14/2023, Ofc. Lopez advised he had again contacted Perez at CVS Pharmacy, located at 530 Truman Ave. During the encounter, Perez again fled the area when confronted by law enforcement, committing additional felony crimes at the location. See Ofc. Lopez's supplemental report for greater details.

I was later informed that Perez was located by dayshift Officers and subsequently taken into custody. Perez was found to be in possession of several of the items stolen during the burglary, including five credit cards belonging to two different victims, staying in the hotel room that was burglarized.

During the initial and continuing investigation into the incident, it was discovered that Perez had used the victims`

credit cards at two separate locations in Key West. The first location was found to be Lime Tree Market, located at 1816 Flagler Ave. It was discovered that a card belonging to Maria Alves, bearing the last four digits of 8863, was used by Perez to fraudulently make purchases of \$25.89 at 0046hrs on 12/14, and a following purchase of \$87.98 at 0050hrs on the same date.

The purchases were confirmed with the market staff and video surveillance was viewed by Ofc. Andrade which showed Perez, wearing the same clothing as I had observed him in, swiping the credit card at the register. Video surveillance of the entire incident is pending retrieval by an IT administrator at the Market and will be uploaded to evidence.com when received.

I was also informed of attempted and completed transactions at 530 Truman Ave (CVS) by Ofc. Lopez. See his case report for greater details.

In addition to Perez's charges by Ofc. Bouvier and Ofc. Lopez, I added the additional criminal charges of:

- 1. Resisting an officer without violence by obstructing the lawful execution of duties.
- 2. Loitering and Prowling: Perez was observed on Kennedy Dr, in an unlit section of the roadway at 11:45pm, wearing all black clothing, directly in front of an active construction site with numerous items of equipment and tools in an unlit area.
- 3. Public Nuisance: Perez committed multiple criminal acts that annoyed the community at large and corrupted the public's morals.
- 4. Trespass on a property other than a structure or conveyance: Perez was observed on video surveillance at 815 Duval St climbing over a secured perimeter fence with an electronically keyed gate. Perez was unable to gain access to the property by any other means outside of having permission and being provided a key card by the business to access the property.
- 5. Use and possession of identification of another- (6 Counts): Perez willfully and without authorization fraudulently possessed and used the personal identification of another without obtaining consent. Perez represented himself to be the named holder of 6 stolen credit cards.
- 6. Theft of a credit card- (6 Counts): Perez intentionally and without permission obtained possession of 6 credit cards

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by theft.

7. Fraudulent use of a credit card (F): Perez with the intent to defraud the owner of the credit card, used the card to obtain goods without the consent of the cardholder. Perez, in a four-minute time frame, used a card in violation of the section two times, with an aggregate total of greater than \$100 (\$113.87).

8. Scheme to defraud, obtaining property under 20k: Perez engaged in a systematic, ongoing course of conduct with the intent to defraud more than one person by false and fraudulent pretenses. Perez committed a burglary which resulted in the unlawful possession of multiple credit cards, then proceeded to make, or attempt multiple purchases. Perez represented himself to be the cardholder during the transactions at two separate locations, causing the deprivation of funds from the owner without consent.

On December 14, 2023, at approximately 0337 hours, I, Ofc. Lopez went inside CVS located at 530 Truman Avenue. I observed a male standing near the front register. This male was wearing a black Adidas jacket, this male appeared to be the same suspect involved in a delayed burglary. This male appeared to be paying the cashier at this moment.

I informed Key West Communications with my location and the subject I observed.

The suspect began walking towards the main entrance with a couple bags. I identified myself as a Police Officer and I informed him that he is being detained. I asked the suspect if he had any weapons and he began stuttering, I told the male to put the bags down. As the suspect was placing the bags down, he said, "What for". I told him to put the bags down, and I told him to put his hands behind his back. The suspect said, "What for" and I told him he was detained as he was matching the description of an individual on ongoing investigation. I pulled out my DEPARTMENT issued TASER, and I informed the suspect if he tries to run, he will be tased. The male began taking a couple steps away from me, and eventually began running towards the isle. I deployed my TASER towards the suspect. I noticed the suspect had a backpack on him, and a dark colored crossbody bag near his waist area. This bag appeared to have a tactical appearance very similar to the 511 brand.

The suspect screamed as he was running through the isle, and he continued running towards the rear side of the store. The suspect was last seen running to the right side of his body, towards the Pharmacy area. The manager informed me that he can lock the main entrance doors and I told him to do that.

I informed Key West Communications that the front doors were locked. I held the main entrance doors, and I holstered my TASER. I pulled out my DEPARTMENT issued firearm.

The business fire alarm went off, and I then I informed Key West Communications. I requested Officers to respond to the intersections of Truman Avenue/Duval Street, and Duval Street/Virginia Street.

I later cleared the store with Sgt. D. Kouri. The suspect exited the store by using the side Fire Emergency Door adjacent to the Almond Tree Inn, (512 Truman Avenue).

It should be noted that this Fire Emergency Door had a separate push style lever which was previously armed prior to the suspect running away. The Fire Emergency Door appeared to be damaged. I attempted to open the door by using the push style lever however it was jammed. This Panic lever was evidently compromised which I confirmed by attempting to open it. The manager attempted to open the emergency door and he was unsuccessful after his attempt. The manager informed me that the emergency door did not have issues in the past. It should be noted that the suspect

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compromised the safety and wellbeing of the employees and its customers by causing damage to his emergency exit lever/panic device.

Based on my training, experience, and certified in the State of Florida as a Code Compliance Officer in the City of Key West, it should be noted that the emergency door is worth approximately, (\$1,300.00). The fire emergency safety device installed on the emergency door is worth approximately, (\$220.00). Those costs excludes labor.

The repairs and installation of this fire emergency door will require a licensed contractor in order to install and obtain required Fire Department's inspections.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

I later gathered the information from the employees that were inside the store.

General Manager, Florida driver's license, Yovierky Guerra Marrero, (dob:11/03/1976). Phone number: (305)587-8083.

Cashier, Florida driver's license, Domingo Miranda, (dob:06/22/1969). Phone number: (305)928-9876.

Cashier, U.S Work permit, Carlos Aguirre Espinoza, (dob:09/03/1976). Phone number: (786)956-7758.

Domingo was working behind the register at the time the suspect was paying for his items. Domingo stated that the suspect tried to use a green debit/credit card and it was declined. The suspect then used a red debit card and it was declined, twice. The suspect then used it again as credit and the transaction was approved. Domingo stated that the suspect exchanged a couple words in Spanish with him. Domingo stated he also works the CVS store located in Stock Island, and he has seen the suspect several times.

Domingo stated the suspect appeared to be under the influence of a drug. However, the suspect has not caused any issues in the store before.

I recovered a CVS receipt of the items the suspect bought with a red debit/credit card. The following items were listed:

- 1. Cantu Avocado hair cream, \$9.29.
- 2. Cantu Shampoo, \$8.59.

The above transactions were used with the following last 4 card numbers, (4709). This credit/debit card belongs to Maria Elviz, (dob:08/01/1999). Maria is one of the victims involved in this burglary. This credit/debit card bank was issued by Sicoob Brazil Bank.

I later used my Axon Capture app to photograph the above CVS receipt. I later uploaded the CVS receipt to Evidence.com.

Ofc. Bouvier later made contact with day shift Officers in an attempt to get the suspect identified. Ofc. Bouvier identified the suspect as Jesus Perez, (12/01/1999).

I later used Law Enforcement resources to locate the photograph taken on Perez's identification card issued in Florida. I reviewed the photograph taken on Perez's and without hesitation I recognized Jesus Perez as the suspect involved in this investigation who also I spoke with inside the CVS store and subsequently fled on foot after instructed he was

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detained.

I later collected the following items that Perez bought inside CVS:

2 shorts, (1 black) and (1 blue).

3 hair products, (Shampoo/Conditioner/Hair cream).

1 neck pillow.

I later packaged and placed the above items into the Key West Police Property/Evidence Section as evidence. I also packaged the TASER cartridges that I deployed from my DEPARTMENT issued TASER cartridges serial numbers were the following:

(X493K7E15) and (X483K4HXF). I placed the TASER cartridges into the Key West Police Property/Evidence Section as evidence.

On December 14, 2023, at approximately 0714 hours, Key West Dispatch received a complaint from a caller indicating a male was sleeping in the backyard located at 418 United Street.

Ofc. Stutz later responded to the above-mentioned residence and made contact with the subject. The subject that was located in this residence was identified as Jesus Perez.

Perez was still wearing the same black Adidas jacket, and black shorts. Perez still had a TASER prong in his body. This TASER prong was located above his left rear side of his buttock.

Perez was taken into custody, and he was later transported by Ofc. Bouvier. Ofc. Bouvier transported Perez to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Once Ofc. Bouvier and Perez were at the Monroe County Detention Center, Perez began resisting. Due to Perez's behavior, and actions, Ofc. Bouvier acquired a broken/fractured bone on his hand. Ofc. Haynie later took over, and he completed the Arrest Affidavit for the resisting charge that occurred at the Monroe County Detention Center.

Based on the facts and evidence, Jesus Perez, did knowingly and willfully refuse and resist to follow my legal verbal instructions. I walked inside the CVS store located at 530 Truman Avenue and I observed Perez standing near the front register. At this time, I observed Perez wearing the same black Adidas jacket, and wearing black shorts which matched the same description of the suspect involved in a burglary of a residence. Perez started walking towards the front main

doors and I identified myself as a Key West Police Officer. I informed Perez that he matches the description of a person involved in an ongoing investigation and at this time he is detained. I instructed Perez to place the plastic bags down on the ground. Perez began questioning why he needed to do that, and I informed him that he is detained, and he needs to follow my instructions due to this investigation. I instructed Perez to place his hands behind his back and he continued questioning why, I pulled out my DEPARTMENT issued TASER. I instructed Perez if he attempts to flee, he will be tased. Perez began taking steps away from me and as he began getting close to the isle, I deployed my TASER. Perez then was running through the isle. I deployed the second TASER cartridge. The male continued running towards the rear side of the store. I was wearing my class B uniform with the Key West Police insignia on my sleeves. I was recognizable as a Police Officer. I was engaging in my legal duties as a Police Officer when I instructed Perez he was detained during this investigation. Contrary to F.S.S. 843.02.

Based on the facts and evidence, Jesus Perez, did knowingly and willfully activated the Alarmed Panic Exit Device installed on this Fire Emergency Door. This Fire Emergency Door is located in-between the Pharmacy area and the cooler/storage room. In Perez's attempt to flee from me, he subsequently activated the Fire Alarm Device without reasonable cause, or legal reasons. Perez activated the Fire Alarm system which I heard while I was inside the store. Contrary to F.S.S. 806.101.

Based on the facts and evidence, Jesus Perez, did knowingly and willfully damage the Alarmed Panic Exit Device installed on this Fire Emergency Door. Based on my training, experience and certified in the State of Florida as a Code Compliance Officer in the City of Key West, it should be noted that the emergency door is worth approximately, (\$1,300.00). The fire emergency safety device installed on the emergency door is worth approximately, (\$220.00). The repairs and installation of this fire emergency door will require a licensed contractor in order to install and obtain required Fire Department's inspections. Perez's actions have caused significant damages worth \$1500.00. Contrary to F.S.S. 806.13(3).

Based on the facts and evidence, Jesus Perez, did knowingly and willfully outrage the sense of public decency, affect the peace of the employees of this establishment due to his actions. While Perez was running through the isles, Perez knocked down several items from the shelfs. It should be noted that Perez interrupted this private licensed establishment from operating. This private licensed establishment was unable to operate for approximately 30 minutes, while the employees were trying to get the Alarmed Fire System disarmed and also picking up the items, restocking the items that were laying down on the ground. It should be noted that the defendant was arrested under F.S.S. 509.143(2). However, this statue is not in FDLE's Arrest Table and I am forced to use F.S.S. 877.03. The defendant should be charged under 509.143(2).
