#### -- Jeffrey William Hodges Arrest Narrative:

On December 30, 2023, at approximately 0206 hours, I, Ofc. Lopez approached the intersection of N. Roosevelt Boulevard and US1. I was traveling on the inside lane of N. Roosevelt Boulevard, (3800 block of N. Roosevelt Boulevard). I came to a final stop for the red traffic light at the above-mentioned intersection.

I noticed a black scooter that was parked approximately 15 feet away beyond the white solid line located at the above-mentioned intersection. It should be noted that there is a painted crosswalk path located beyond this stop bar/white solid line. This scooter was in violation of F.S.S. 316.074, (Disregarding a traffic control device). The scooter was facing the inside lane red left turning traffic light. There was a pink Taxi that was parked in the outside lane of traffic waiting for the red light to turn green.

As I was watching the scooter parked for a few seconds, I noticed the scooter was moving side to side, (Left to right several times). I noticed a male driver and a female passenger were the occupants of this scooter. The female passenger appeared to be asleep as she maintained her eyes closed during my observation and currently seated on the scooter. (I activated my In-car Axon camera, 3722 and the above information was captured).

At this time, I made the decision to conduct a traffic stop at a safe location and not at the intersection of N. Roosevelt Boulevard and US1. The scooter appeared as if it was waiting for the traffic light to turn green and then make a left turn onto US1. I believed having a person asleep seated on a moving scooter as a passenger could potentially lead to an accident due to the possibility of the passenger waking up to emergency lights as the driver is making a turn. It should be noted that there a Taxi traveling in the same direction as well.

Once the traffic light turned green the scooter made a left turn onto US1, and it continued traveling outbound on US1. I determined conducting the traffic stop a bit further due to the fact the scooter was getting close to the Cow Key Channel Bridge, (Outbound).

I was in a Key West Police marked vehicle equipped with emergency lights and sirens. I activated my emergency lights and sirens in an attempt to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle near the intersection of US1 and College Road.

The vehicle was traveling in the outside lane of traffic, (US1). The vehicle began slowing down and moving closer to the white solid line of this lane. The vehicle continued traveling outbound on US1, passing the intersection of US1 and Cross Street. I was traveling in the same direction behind it. However, the vehicle did not stop. The vehicle continued traveling outbound on US1, and it was evident that there was no other moving vehicle that the driver could have possibly thought I was trying to stop. The vehicle continued traveling outbound on US1, the vehicle passed the Chevron Gas Station located at 5220 Overseas Highway. The vehicle proceeded by turning onto Macdonald Avenue, as the vehicle was making this turn, the vehicle came close to hitting the curb near the sidewalk and then drifted towards the curb on the opposite side. I used my PA system equipment installed in my patrol vehicle to instruct the vehicle to stop. I noticed the male driver on this vehicle looked back. However, he continued traveling on Macdonald Avenue. The vehicle came to a final stop approximately 100 feet away after looking back. The final stop was near the intersection of Macdonald Avenue and 5th Street.

I informed Key West Communications with the pattern of the vehicle and a Monroe County Sheriff Deputy was dispatched to assist.

I used the PA system again to instruct the driver to turn off the vehicle and walk towards the sidewalk several times.

This vehicle was bearing Virginia registration W83241. The male driving this vehicle was later identified with his Virginia driver's license as Jeffrey Hodges, (dob:05/06/1980).

I identified myself and I informed Jeffrey with the reason of the traffic stop. I explained to Jeffrey that he parked his vehicle approximately 15 feet away from the white solid line/stop bar at the above-mentioned intersection. I informed Jeffrey that I noticed while he was waiting for the traffic light to turn green, himself and the vehicle were moving side to side. I also mentioned to Jeffrey that I activated my emergency blue lights and sirens approximately 3 blocks away from this location. However, he did not stop the vehicle.

I requested Jeffrey to provide me with his driver's license and registration. Jeffrey became argumentative and made several statements that he just picked up the female passenger and he was taking her home. I told Jeffrey to provide me with his driver's license and registration again. However, Jeffrey continued displaying an antagonistic demeanor and diverting from my instructions. While Jeffrey was standing on the edge of the sidewalk, he leaned his upper body forward towards my direction as he was losing his balance. I took a step back to maintain a safe distance as he was getting very agitated. Jeffrey made a comment about me taking a step back and I informed him that he just leaned his upper body towards my direction while I was giving him instructions. I instructed Jeffrey by the third time that I am requesting him to provide me with his driver's license and registration. However, Jeffrey refused to provide me with the documents I requested.

At this time, I instructed Jeffrey to place his hands behind his back and I began walking towards him. Jeffrey took approximately 2-3 steps back attempting to get away from me. I was able to grab his right wrist area and he actively continued pulling his arm away from me. As I was trying to gain control of his hands, Jaffrey continued refusing to place his hands behind his back. I proceeded by escorting Jeffrey to the ground by pulling his right-side upper body towards the ground to attempt to gain control of his hands. As I was escorting Jeffrey to the ground, Jeffrey continued actively pulling his arms away and tensing up his body. Once Jeffrey and I were on the ground, I pulled Jeffrey's right hand behind his back, and he continued pulling his arm away from me. The Monroe County Sheriff Deputy assisted me by grabbing Jeffrey's left arm. Jeffrey turned his body towards his right side in an attempt to face me. As Jeffrey was turning his upper body towards me, I redirected his upper body away from me by applying pain compliance on his right wrist and placing my right hand against his shoulder area. I instructed Jeffrey to stop resisting and he continued being combative and tensing up his body.

Detective Marcus Del Valle, Monroe County Sherrif Deputy and I had to actively pull his hands towards his back and maintain them in order to place handcuffs on him.

My body worn camera was knocked down to the ground during this incident. This incident was recorded with my In-Car Axon camera 3722.

I later placed my body worn camera on my vest and then I conducted a search on Jeffrey. I instructed Jeffrey to place his body up against my vehicle. Jeffrey was yelling at the Monroe County Sherriff Deputy very loudly to the extent the Deputy advised him that he was getting spit on his face. Jeffrey shortly after stopped yelling at the Deputy. This was captured with my body worn camera, 3722.

During this encounter, I noticed Jeffrey had dilated pupils, glassy eyes, and I smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I noticed Jeffrey lost his balance while he was standing on his feet and leaned his upper body towards my direction. The Deputy also advised me that he smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath.

I then Informed Jeffrey that I have reason to believe he is operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage or narcotic to the point his normal faculties as a human being are impaired to safely operate a motor vehicle. I requested Jeffrey to participate to Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises to dispel my suspicions that he is operating a motor vehicle under the influence of an alcoholic beverage or narcotic to the point his normal faculties as a human being are impaired to safely operate a motor vehicle. Jeffrey refused to participate.

I then informed Jeffrey with his Taylor warning. Jeffrey was informed that failure to participate in (SFSE), I will have to make an arrest decision based on what I have seen of him so far, and this can be used against him as evidence. Jeffrey refused again to participate in (SFSE). I later placed Jeffrey in the rear passenger seat of my patrol vehicle.

Based on my training and experience in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises, and Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement, and the totality of circumstances; his physical appearance, strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath, I believe Jeffrey was impaired by either an alcoholic beverage, Drug or Narcotic, which impaired his normal faculties to safely operate a motor vehicle.

Ofc. Ua was on scene, and he released the scooter to Jeffrey's father. Jeffrey's father claimed to be the registered owner of the vehicle.

I informed Sgt. Malsheimer and Sgt. T. Peters of the incident.

I later transported Jeffrey to the Monroe County Detention Center. My In-car Axon camera, 3722 was activated during the transportation.

Sgt. T. Peters spoke with Jeffrey at the MCDC.

I instructed Jeffrey to sit down on a blue chair in the report writing room. The 20-minute-observation period began at approximately 0301 hours. I read Jeffrey his Implied Consent Warning and when he was asked if he understood, Jeffrey said, "Yes". I requested Jeffrey to consent to a lawful test of his breath and he agreed. I instructed Jeffrey to remain seated on the chair and to please not to touch his mouth for the next 20 minutes. However, Jeffrey placed his hand on his mouth within approximately 5-10 seconds. It is evident Jeffrey does not wish to cooperate based on his actions and aggressive demeanor. I later entered a refusal entry for Jeffrey. This was captured with my body worn camera, 3722. It should be noted, I am a certified breath test operator in the State of Florida and do possess a valid, in date, permit to administer such test. The instrument used is the Intoxilyzer 8000 S/N 80-007167.

Jeffrey was issued the following UNIFORM DUI CITATION: AIGHE5E, (DUI Alcohol or Drugs).

Jeffrey was issued the following UNIFORM TRAFFIC CITATION: AIGHE6E, (Disregarding a traffic control device).

Jeffrey was assigned a Court date on January 19, 2024, with Judge Wilson, 9:00 am, at the Key West Courthouse. I explained to Jeffrey he was assigned a criminal court date, and he is responsible to appear at the above date and time in front of Judge Wilson. Jeffrey became confrontational and did not provide his signature. I explained to Jeffrey that his signature is not admission to guilt. Jeffrey asked me if he could read it and I said he could. Jeffrey did not make the attempt to sign it and proceeded by trying to argue that he did not do anything wrong. I asked Jeffrey to sign the citation and he did not sign it. (This was captured with my body worn camera, 3722).

Jeffrey was issued the following UNIFORM TRAFFIC CITATION: AIGHE7E, (Refused to sign accept citation).

Based on the facts and evidence, Jeffrey Hodges, did knowingly and willfully refuse to follow my verbal instructions during a lawful traffic stop. I was conducting my legal duties as a Police Officer when I requested Jeffrey to provide me with his driver's license and registration. I requested Jeffrey to provide these documents 3 times and he refused to do so. I was wearing my class B uniform with the Key West Police insignia on my sleeves. I initially identified

On Saturday, December 30, 2023, I Detective Marcus del Valle assisted KWPD Officer Jorge Lopez on a traffic stop at 5th Street and Macdonald Ave in Key West Florida 33040. As I pulled up to the location, I observed a parked scooter next to the sidewalk and Officer Lopez was speaking with a male and female who were standing on the sidewalk. I later identified the unknown male and female by their Virginia driver license as Jeffrey William Hodges, date of birth May 6, 1980, and Jacueline Faye Hodges, date of birth December 4, 1980. Officer Lopez was speaking with Hodges informing him as to the reason why he was stopped. Hodges was uncooperative and would not produce his identification or vehicle information.

Hodges was very irate and demonstrating a belligerent behavior towards Officer Lopez. Hodges did exhibit an aggressive posture towards Officer Lopez. Officer Lopez had to ask him to step back.

After numerous request, Hodges continued his actions not producing his Driver license, Officer Lopez attempted to handcuff Hodges, he resisted and would not comply with Officer Lopez verbal commands. Hodges was taken to the ground in a modified takedown, and we handcuffed him without incident.

As we were dealing with Hodges, Jacueline was highly intoxicated I had to give her numerous verbal commands to stand back.

Hodges scooter was released to his father who came to the scene, he also picked up Jacueline due to her intoxication level she could not drive the scooter.

I had no further involvement in this case.
