RESOLUTION NO. 24-018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING DAILY PLAN-IT AND KEY WEST FIRST LEGAL RUM COMPANY TO CONDUCT A " IT'S 5 O'CLOCK KEY WEST EVENT" AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT GREEN FIELDS NEXT TO THE SPLASH PAD AND A SECOND LINE WALKING PARADE HONORING JIMMY BUFFETT'S LEGACY ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF HIS DEATH ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2024, FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; **AUTHORIZING** SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the Daily Plan-it and Key West First Legal Rum Company has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for a "It's 5 O'clock Key West Event" at the Key West Truman Waterfront Park and on and a second line walking parade honoring Jimmy Buffet legacy on the anniversary of his death on Duval Street from Front to Southard Street, Sunday, September 1, 2024, from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city

Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public

property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship

with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless
such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are

neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Daily Plan-it and Key West First Legal Rum Company are hereby granted permission to conduct a "It's 5 O'clock Key West event" on the day and during the hours stated above.

PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Daily Plan-it and Key West First Legal Rum Company are hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Daily Plan-it and Key West First Legal Rum Company must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age. Proof of compliance with Supplement F, paragraph 3 of the application is required at least ten (10) days in advance.

SECTION 6. That Daily Plan-it and Key West First Legal Rum Company will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
