-- James Allen Durham Arrest Narrative:

On Sunday, January 7, 2024, at 0915 hours, I heard KWPD Com 1 dispatch Ofc. B. Leahy and another unit to the Circle K (formerly Uppy's) at 3700 N. Roosevelt Blvd. regarding a shoplifter. I also responded and arrived at 0922.

On my arrival, Officers G. Medina, B. Leahy, and D. Agleev were already on scene. They had a white male suspect (later identified as James Durham DOB 10/16/1974 per a FL ID) detained in handcuffs right outside the main entrance to the convenient store, near one of their patrol vehicles. As I approached, I heard Durham telling the officers that he was "willing to pay for it," which I understood to mean the item that had been reported as stolen by the store. Durham continued to make an offer to pay for the items.

Ofc. Leahy stated he had already met with the reporting party, Circle K employee Terry Scott. Scott had told Ofc. Leahy that he had seen Durham inside his store multiple times that morning prior to our arrival. Scott had finally called KWPD because he witnessed Durham take two Twisted Teas (24 oz alcoholic beverages) from the store, and then leave the store without paying. Scott also told Ofc. Leahy that Durham consumed both beverages on the Circle K property, behind the store. Scott provided a receipt for the two stolen items, which showed the value at \$7.73. Scott stated he was going to check with a manager later today to attempt to get video footage of the shoplifting.

I instructed the officers that I would handle the arrest as the location was inside the zone to which I was assigned. At that time, we began walking Durham to my patrol car. Ofc. Agleev placed Durham in the backseat of my patrol car; however, at that time I observed Durham refuse to fully get inside the car. Durham resisted and struggled to the extent that Ofc. Agleev's BWC was knocked off its mount while he attempted to get Durham into the vehicle. Durham's back was leaned against the partition that separates the two backseats, and his legs were extended outside the car. I begin attempting to pull Durham by the shirt to get his back properly against the back of the seat while Ofc. Agleev attempted to get Durham's legs inside the vehicle. Ofc. Medina then stepped in to assist Ofc. Agleev get him sitting properly in the back seat. Durham continued to brace and oppose our efforts to get him properly seated in the car, so that we could put on the seatbelt. While we were struggling with him, he was told by two different officers that if he didn't stop bracing, then he would either be "drive-stunned," or pepper-sprayed. At that time, I heard Durham yell, "Fuck you," then I both heard and saw him spit at the officers, and I saw that Ofc. Agleev and Ofc. Medina were both struck in the face with Durham's saliva. Immediately after that, Ofc. Leahy pepper-sprayed Durham in the face.

I immediately notified sergeants via Com1 that we needed a supervisor due to a response to resistance incident, and Sgt. Siracuse responded to the scene. While there, Sgt. Siracuse placed a "spit-hood" on Durham for the duration of the transport.

I then transported Durham to the ER at Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance, and Ofc. Agleev followed to assist. Durham received medical clearance by the ER staff and was cleared for transport to the Monroe County Detention Center (MCDC).

Based on Scott's statement that he witnessed Durham steal the two alcoholic beverages, and Durham's spontaneous statements that he was "willing to pay" for the items, I have reason to believe Durham permanently deprived the business of the full retail value of the merchandise, in violation of F.S.S. 812.014(3A), petit theft less than \$100.

Based on my personally observing Durham bracing and struggling to be placed into my patrol car to complete the shoplifting arrest, I have reason to believe Durham resisted and opposed the officers who were engaged in the lawful

On Sunday, January 7th, 2024, Officer Dennis Agleev, Officer Brian Leahy, Officer Anna Anglin and I Officer Gustavo Medina responded to 3700 N Roosevelt Blvd (Circle K Uppys) in reference to a theft. Dispatch stated that the Reporting Person (Store Clerk Terry Scott) informed dispatch that a white male "scruffy, wearing blue shirt and blue shorts" go into the store and stole a twisted tea. Scott advised dispatch that the suspect was drinking it out back of the store. The description of the individual described by Scott provided me with the possible identity of an individual I had several encounters with on Friday, January 5th, so i responded to this incident.

Upon arrival, Officer B. Leahy and Officer D. Agleev were already on scene and with the suspect inside the store. The identity of the suspect was indeed the same individual I had encounters with previously on Friday as James Durham (DOB 10/16/1974). Those encounters involved me trespassing Durham from three separate locations on the outside of town (CAD#240050142).

While inside the store I observed Officer Leahy speaking with the Reporting Person Terry Scott, while Officer Agleev was informing Durham that the store wished to press charges for shoplifting and that he was being arrested. Durham began resisting Officer Agleev's attempt to place him in handcuffs and that was when I assisted in the detainment. I grabbed Durham's left arm; which he attempted to pull away and brace from my grasp. I was then able to pull his left arm back till Officer Agleev was able to place it inside the handcuffs. Officer Agleev and I then escorted Durham outside the store to Officer Agleev's patrol vehicle. Durham continued to spontaneously utter that he would be willing to pay for the merchandise. Durham was informed that he committed theft by still temporarily or permanently depriving the store of their merchandise and they wished to press charges.

Durham's belongings and person was then searched incident to arrest. officer Anna Anglin arrived on scene and became the primary officer of the case. Officer Anglin was informed of our findings and investigation of the theft committed by Durham. Durham was then being escorted to Officer Anglin's patrol vehicle for transport to Monroe County Jail. Durham continued to brace, pull his legs and use them as leverage to not go inside the patrol vehicle. Durham failed to comply and defy lawful commands to enter the back seat of the patrol car. Officer B. Leahy also issued lawful commands for Durham to comply or that he would be drive stunned or pepper sprayed using our nonlethal devices. Officer Agleev and I were finally able to place Durham in the backseat and place the safety belt over his shoulders. Immediately after placing the seatbelt on Durham, he aggressively faced towards Officer Agleev and I and replied, "Fuck you" and spit. Durham's saliva landed on both Officer Agleev and I's person. Most of the violent spit landed on Officer Agleev; however, I felt immediate wetness around the top portion of my forehead; which promptly had me wipe my forehead in response.

At the point I pulled away and Officer Leahy used his pepper spray in response to Durham's resistance.

On 01/07/2024, at approximately 0913 hours, Officers Medina, Agleev, A. Anglin and I, Officer Leahy responded to 3700 North Roosvelt Blvd. (Circle K) in reference to a theft.

Upon arrival, Officer Agleev contacted a white male inside the store's bathroom, who Officer Medina and I knew as James Durham. Officer Medina and I have had multiple encounters with Durham throughout the weekend in reference to Durham trespassing on multiple properties. Officer Agleev escorted Durham out of the bathroom. The store clerk, identified by his Florida driver's license as Terry Scott, stated Durham had been inside the store at least 12 times during the morning of the above date. Scott said, before our arrival to the store, Durham had stolen 2 cans of Twisted Tea alcoholic beverages from the store and proceeded outside past all points of sales to consume the beverages behind the store. Scott said he talked to his manager who told Scott Circle K wanted to press charges against Durham.

Officer Agleev attempted to handcuff Durham who made a several spontaneous utterances that he would pay for the merchandise. Durham kept trying to pull away from Officer Agleev and Medina as they were trying to handcuff him. Durham was finally placed in handcuffs and escorted outside by Officer Agleev and Medina and subsequently escorted to Officer A. Anglin's patrol vehicle. Officer Agleev attempted to place Durham in the back of the patrol vehicle, but Durham used his legs and feet to grasp the bottom of the patrol vehicle door thwarting Officer Agleev's attempts to place Durham in the patrol vehicle. Durham kept stating he would pay door the merchandise. I told Durham if he did get in the back of the patrol vehicle I was going to "Drive Stun" him with my TASER. Officer Agleev kept trying to force Durham's legs into the patrol vehicle, i told Durham I was going to use pepper spray if he continued to resist us. Officer Agleev forced Durham's legs into the vehicle then seat belted Durham. Durham turned towards Officer Agleev and said "Fuck You" then spit in Officer Agleev's face. The spit also struck Officer Medina. I pointed my pepper spray at Durham's head area and deployed two bursts of pepper spray. Durham immediately became compliant. I placed a spit mask onto Durham's head which Sgt. Siracuse provided to me.

Durham was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance by Officer A. Anglin then subsequently transported to the Monroe County Detention Center.

On January 7, 2024, at approximately 0900 hours I, Officer Agleev, responded to 3700 North Roosevelt Boulevard (Circle K), reference a theft.

Upon arrival I observed a white male matching the description of the suspect walking inside the store. The suspect was later identified by his Florida ID as James Durham (DOB 10/16/1974, Arrestee in case 24-0096). I followed Durham inside.

The employee of the store pointed at Durham and advised, they were pressing theft charges against him.

Officer Medina arrived on scene and assisted me in handcuffing Durham. Durham was pulling away his arms trying to break our efforts to cuff him. He kept tensing his body while I walked him to Officer A. Anglin's patrol car and refused to get inside the vehicle. I had to lift his legs and push Durham inside the vehicle. After I buckled Durham's seatbelt, he started throwing profanities and spit at me and Officer Medina, who was standing next to me. Officer Leahy had to use pepper spray on Durham to stop him from spitting.

Officer Anglin transported Durham to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance and later to the Monroe County Detention Center. I assisted Officer Anglin with Durham's escort at both locations.

My BWC was activated and uploaded to Axon Evidence.
