

RESOLUTION NO. 24-038

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,509.56 FOR THE MILLING, PAVING, AND STRIPING OF THE SIMONTON BEACH PARKING LOT; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 21-125, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities and Infrastructure Services Contract with Charly Toppino & Sons, Inc. ; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of a change order to the milling, paving, and striping of the Simonton Beach Parking Lot

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached change order under the City's General Utility Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total not to exceed \$6,509.56, for the milling, paving, and striping of the Simonton Beach Parking Lot, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funding is budgeted FY23-24 in Infrastructure Surtax/Parks and Recreation/Infrastructure account 101-7201-572-6300. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments

are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
