A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE CITY ATTORNEY TO ENGAGE PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANTS AND COMMISSION STUDIES TO DETERMINE RISKS, BENEFITS PUBLIC INTEREST IN PLACING A REFERENDUM FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ON THE NOVEMBER 5 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT: AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS AND ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 14, 2024, the City Commission discussed in concept the issuance of General Obligation bonds to fund improvements for streets, sidewalks, public safety and parks projects, to improve resiliency to flooding and storm events and to reduce traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds it reasonable to direct staff to obtain further information as to the feasibility of a general obligation bond issue of up to \$300,000,000; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager and the City Attorney are authorized to engage professional consultants to determine risks, benefits and public interest in placing a referendum for a public obligation bond issue of up to \$300,000,000 on the November 5, 2024 general election ballot.
