-- Jared William Rockness Arrest Narrative:

On 02/02/2023, at 0723 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was dispatched to Catherine and Simonton St. in reference to a battery.

Upon arrival, I was flagged down by a male who stated that a male approached him and struck him. He stated the male walked north on Simonton St. I was then showed a video where a white male with long blonde dreadlocks, wearing a blue long sleeve shirt and grey shorts was walking away. I put out a BOLO for the male over the radio to try to locate the male. The reporting party stated that they did not want to press charges. The reporting party stated that if I needed to reach him for more information to call him at 305-896-3667. I began to look for the male.

I began to drive around the area and I heard Ofc. S. Perez state that he was out with the male inside of 1075 Duval St. I drove over to 1075 Duval St., I saw Ofc. S. Perez and Ofc. Medina attempting to detain the male from Simonton and Catherine St. the male was being given several loud verbal commands to stop resisting but he continued to pull away and continued to resist. I assisted Ofc. S. Perez in gaining control of the male's arms and placing him in handcuffs. The male was screaming a bunch of nonsensical things. The male was later identified by his Florida Dl as Jared Rockness.

After detaining the male, I noticed he had 4 TASER prongs on his body (See Ofc. Medina's supplemental report). I walked out to my car and retrieved the TASER prong removal device. I removed the prongs, placed the prongs inside of the cartage, placed the cartridge inside of the prong removal device, and then placed all of it into an evidence bag.

I was handed Rockness' backpack by the cashier of Circle K. The backpack contained random items, a wallet and a rolled-up joint containing an unknown substance. Ofc. S. Santiago took the joint and the prongs and placed them into the KWPD Property and Evidence Division.

I spoke to a male identified by his Florida DL as Emzela Mack who stated that he was sitting outside of the store and saw Rockness walk in. Rockness began to yell at the cashier. Mack got in between Rockness and the cashier and told him to back away. Rockness then began to hit the cash register and hit items near the register. Mack and other people on scene stated that they were afraid for their safety and the safety of the cashier. They stated that Rockness' actions were alarming.

Rockness was taken to Lower Keys Medical Center due to his excited delirium and the TASER deployment. Rockness had several small puncture wounds from the TASER prongs as well.

The Medical staff at LKMC medically cleared Rockness and advised me that he was under the effects of meth and marijuana.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 02/04/2024, Jared Rockness did knowingly and willingly resist Ofc. S. Perez, Ofc. Medina and my lawful orders without violence, obstructing Ofc. S. Perez, Ofc. Medina and I from conducting our legal duties violating F.S.S. 843.02 resisting officer without violence.

Furthermore, Jared Rockness did knowingly and intentionally, commit several acts that corrupted public morals and disturbed the peace and quiet of others, by screaming and attempting to fight several people violating F.S.S. 877.03 disorderly conduct.

On Sunday, February 4, 2024, at approximately 0736 hours, Officer Randy Perez, Officer Santiago Perez and I Officer Gustavo Medina were dispatched to a battery incident at the intersection of Catherine Street and Simonton Street. Dispatch advised that the Reporting Person informed them that the subject involved with the RP was "talking crazy", getting in his face and could still here the subject yelling in the background.

Upon my arrival, Officer R. Perez was already on scene speaking with the Reporting Person. Officer Perez stated the white male subject involved was wearing a long sleeve shirt and dreadlocks and was last seen walking northbound on Simonton Street. I began patrolling the area when I stopped and asked a couple if they had seen the described white male. They informed me that he turned off on Truman Avenue heading towards Duval Street.

I began driving southbound on Duval Street in my marked patrol vehicle. While coming towards circle K at 1075 Duval Street I noticed several people outside flagging down Officer Santiago Perez in his marked patrol vehicle coming northbound on Duval Street. We were informed there was a white male matching the description (later identified as Jared Rockness) inside the store going crazy. When we opened the front doors to Circle K, we observed Rockness walking inside the store swinging his arms around and acting bizzare and erratic. We were dressed in our class B police uniforms and gave clear loud lawful commands to step outside. Our lawful commands were ignored by Rockness, and he was speaking nonsensically and acting erratic. I pulled out my Tazer 7 device and informed Rockness if he did not comply that he will be Tased. Rockness was still displaying erratic behavior. In Rockness altered state of mind and aggressive movements by the door entrance I deployed my Taser making the subject fall to the floor. Subject was still resisting on the floor and was tasered again by activating another trigger pull on the device to obtain compliance (two cycles of the Taser device). Officer Perez attempted to restrain Rockness arms and hands due to his resistance and not placing his hands behind his back with lawful commands. Rockness continued to pull and brace his hands and arms from Officer Perez's grasp. Rockness continued to display an altered state of mind and kept yelling and saying incoherent and nonsensical words and statements. Rockness began kicking Officer Santiago Perez and I had to restrain his legs and feet from continuing to kick at Officer S. Perez. Officer Randy Perez arrived on scene and began assisting us in placing Rockness in handcuffs. Rockness was also eventually placed in a hobble (which is a restraining device used to limit the movement of the feet and legs of a subject).

While attempting to place Rockness in restraints I observed that two Taser prongs were deployed in his chest, another prong on his left waist area of his torso and the fourth prong was projecting from the right thigh of his leg. Officer Perez began removing the prongs from Rockness torso my right thumb was punctured in the process of attempting to swipe the prongs away from the floor next to Rockness.

Key West Fire Rescue was called to the scene and had to administer medications to calm Rockness from his altered

state. Rescue personnel transported Rockness to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical evaluation. I drove to Lower Keys Medical Center until Officer R. Perez arrived on scene to take over custodial arrest of Rockness. Lower Keys Medical Center advised that drug testing administered on Rockness system showed positive results for Methamphetamine (Meth) and Marijuana.

On Sunday, February 4, 2024, at approximately 0736 hours, Officer Randy Perez was dispatched to a battery on Catherine and Simonton St. Officer Medina and I, Officer Santiago Perez also responded to the scene.

On my arrival Officer R. Perez was talking to a Hispanic white male the victim of the battery call. The victim showed us a video taken with a cellular phone showing a white male doing all kind of crazy gestures and walking in different directions. Officer R. Perez and I were informed by the victim that he was just touched by the suspect and did not want to pursue charges. At this point I had a clear view of how the suspect looked, and I drove around to locate him.

I was driving my marked patrol vehicle north bound on Duval Street and was flagged down by a group of people outside Circe K, located at 1075 Duval. I was told there was a white male inside the store going crazy. Officer Medina also arrived at Circle K. Officer Medina and I observed the white male walking inside the store swinging his arms around Officer Medina and I asked the subject to step out of the store. Our lawful commands were ignored by the subject, and he was slurring words that were not understandable. Officer Medina and I at this moment had the subject at taser point and was still not complying. Subject continued to be erratic and kept making sudden aggressive movements by the door entrance. Officer Medina deployed his taser making the subject fall to the floor. Subject was still resisting on the floor and was tazered again by Officer Medina. I got on the subject's back and held his arms attempting to handcuff him. The subject keept slurring words and refusing to put his hands behind his back at this point the subject swung punches at me using one arm reaching my face at one point. Subject began kicking me as well. Officer Medina had to restrain his legs and feet. Subject was eventually placed in a hobble (which is a restraining device used to limit the movement of the feet and legs of a subject). Officer Randy Perez helped me handcuff the subject.

The subject was taking into custody and Key West Fire Rescue was called to the scene. The subject was sedated on the scene. The Rescue personnel transported the subject to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical evaluation. See Officer Medinas's supplemental report. See Officer Randy Perez arrest affidavit. My body worn Camera was activated during the encounter with the subject. I packaged the evidence and submitted it to the Key West Police Property and Evidence Division. I had no further involvement on this case.
