AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE MAP OF THE CITY KEY WEST COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PROPERTIES LOCATED AT 715 SEMINOLE AVENUE AND 811 SEMINOLE AVENUE; AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP LEGEND FROM HISTORIC RESIDENTIAL TO HISTORIC COMMERCIAL FOR PARCELS STATED ABOVE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 90, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE STATE LAND PLANNING AGENCY; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE INCLUSION INTO THE CITY OF KEY WEST COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West (the "City") has adopted a Comprehensive Plan which has been found to be in compliance by the State Department of Community Affairs ("DCA"), pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City is located within the Florida Keys

Area of Critical State Concern(the "FKACSC") as established

pursuant to Chapter 380, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 163,

166, and 380 of the Florida State Statutes, the City of Key West, Florida (the "City") proposes to amend the boundaries for the property at 715 Seminole Avenue (RE # 00037230-000100; AK# 8735669) and 811 Seminole Avenue (RE # 00037160-000100; AK# 8735677) from the Historic Residential (HR) designation to the Historic Commercial (HC) designation; and


WHEREAS, the proposed amendment will further the goals, objectives, and policies of the City Comprehensive Plan; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the above recitals are incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: That the Future Land Use Map of the City of Key West, Florida is hereby recommended for amendment for the property at 715 Seminole Avenue (RE # 00037230-000100; AK# 8735669) and 811 Seminole Avenue (RE # 00037160-000100; AK# 8735677) from the Historic Residential (HR) designation to the Historic Commercial (HC) designation and will appear as follows:

Section 3: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be constructed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission and approval by the Florida Department of Commerce, pursuant to Chapter 380, Florida Statutes.
