5. Crosswalk, west of 3 Street (USCIS Building)








CONSISTENCY WITH RELATED FDOT/CITY PROJECTS



FDOT RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on analysis of data, Federal and FDOT standards:

- RRFB installation is recommended at the mid-block crosswalks for improving pedestrian safety that represents context-sensitive and a system-wide approach.
- Upgrade lighting at all 6 crosswalks.
- Monitor operations and compliance after RRFB implementation
