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A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AWARDING THE BID OF KEARNS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR "REBID: HALF SHELL RAW BAR SEAWALL REPAIRS," IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$444,840.00, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS SPECIFIED IN ITB 17-019; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CRA/CITY OF KEY WEST IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH DOCUMENTS CONTAINED IN THE BID PACKAGE, UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; WAIVING MINOR INCONSISTENCIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in November 2016, the City issued Invitation to bid 17-002 for Half Shell Raw Bar Seawall Repairs, and rejected the sole bid received in response, pursuant to best interests of the City, because the cost proposal exceeded budgeted funds; and

WHEREAS, the City re-issued an Invitation for Bid Half Shell Raw Bar Seawall Repairs in ITB #17-019, and one firm submitted a response on April 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the response and contacted the sole bidder to request corrections and clarifications to calculation of bid line item #1, and for proof of experience in marine construction, and Kearns Construction in response provided additional information which satisfied the requirements contained in the ITB; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends waiving the minor irregularities, which were cured in a timely manner by the vendor; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Kearns Construction Company for "Rebid: Half Shell Raw Bar Seawall Repairs," in an amount not to exceed \$444,840.00, in accordance with ITB No.17-019, is hereby awarded.

Section 2: That minor inconsistencies in the original submitted bid are waived.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with documents contained in the bid package, as amended, on behalf of the City of Key West, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect
