A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT WITH PAL (KEY WEST POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE) FOR USE OF THE GYMNASIUM AT THE JOSEPHINE PARKER CITY HALL AT THE HISTORIC GLYNN R. ARCHER SCHOOL, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, repairs and improvements to the Gymnasium located at City Hall are in progress; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that upon completion of the repairs and improvements, it would be beneficial to authorize use of the gymnasium by PAL, for classes and activities benefitting the youth of Key West; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that occupancy of the property by PAL, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in a negotiated agreement, would provide a valuable public benefit and is otherwise consistent with City Code of Ordinances section 2-941(c);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate an Agreement with PAL (the Key West Police Athletic League) for use of the gymnasium at the Josephine Parker City Hall at the Historic Glynn R. Archer School, subject to approval by the City Commission.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
