## **MEDIATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

If the settlement is not approved by the City, the agreement shall be void and of no further force and effect.

Each party agrees to be solely responsible for the payment of their respective attorney's fees and costs as a result of or in connection with the Lawsuit or this Settlement Agreement.

Payment of the sums due under this Settlement Agreement is expressly conditioned upon ((a) the execution of the release to be provided and the entry of an Order of Dismissal with Prejudice by the Court.
