Purchase of Tree Planting Materials

A motion was made by Commissioner Denise Bravo, seconded by Madam Vice-Chair Robin Robinson, that the estimate from Quick Sand and Fill Corp be approved to purchase soil. The motion passed by an unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Denise Bravo, seconded by Commissioner Glenn Kapsch, in accordance with Sec. 110-291 that the City of Key West enter into a settlement agreement with the property owner requiring replanting with 68.4 caliper inches, with each tree being at least 4 inches minimum, from the approved tree list FL #1 to be planted on site, as well as a \$1,000.00 fine from the property owner.
