A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING WORK ORDER #1 UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES SERVICES CONTRACT WITH D.N. HIGGINS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$182,728.46 FOR REPAIR OF CITY SIDEWALKS DAMAGED HURRICANE IRMA; APPROVING AN ADDENDUM TO THE GENERAL UTILITIES SERVICES CONTRACT INCORPORATE FEDERAL CONTRACTING REQUIRED FOR FEMA REIMBURSEMENT; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Irma caused significant damage to the City of Key West on and around September 10, 2017, including damage to many concrete sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities Services contract with Douglas N. Higgins; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments to the City's General Services

Contract are necessary to incorporate federal contracting

provisions required for FEMA reimbursement after the hurricane;

and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Work Order #1 for the repair of City sidewalks after Hurricane Irma, under the City's General Services Contract with Douglas N. Higgins, Inc. is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$182,728.46.

Section 2: That the attached Addendum to General Utilities
Service Contract is hereby approved, incorporating certain Federal
Contracting Clauses required for FEMA reimbursement.

Section 3: That funds from Account No. HU 0011910-5196500 (Project HU1700000001C01-5196500) (Hurricane Irma Recovery) will be used for this project, and any necessary budget adjustments are authorized.

Section 4: That the City Manager is authorized to execute necessary documents, including the Work Order, Contract Addendum and any necessary budget adjustments.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
