A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$149,329.00 FOR THE TRIMMING AND DISPOSAL OF MANGROVES AT THE CITY'S EIGHT SFWMD PERMITTED MAINTENANCE SITES FOR STORMWATER MANAGEMENT; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City acquired maintenance permits from the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) to trim mangroves and dredge waterways used specifically to collect discharge stormwater flows; and

WHEREAS, the City's permit allows ongoing trimming and maintenance within the SFWMD guidelines, and due to Hurricane Irma, trimming originally budgeted and planned for September 2017 (FY17) was delayed until FY18; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order under the City's General Utilities Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$149,329.00, for mangrove trimming and

disposal at the City's eight stwho permitted maintenance sites is
hereby approved.
Section 2: That funds will be transferred from stormwater
reserves.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by
the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
