The following is a potential list of tasks that could be performed by the filled position working with many others from participating departments

### **Work with Planning Dept to:**

- Track and apply for grant funding for any of the needs identified below.
- Complete Bike Ped Master Plan
- Review development plans for bike/ped concerns and solutions. Interact with citizens.
- Implement policies in Comprehensive Plan.
  - o Assess new BMP's as they relate to our situation
  - o Create proactive bike and walk friendly policy language for Land Development Regulations
  - o Research and Create pilot Transportation Mitigation Funding program.
  - o Assess major bike routes for Comp Plan and suggest changes.
- Implement Actions in Climate Action Plan
  - o Research and Implement Car Share program
  - o Increase Bike Routes on local maps
  - o Achieve Bike Friendly Platinum status for the City of Key West
  - o Achieve Walk Friendly Platinum certification for the City of Key West
  - o Organize walking and biking events.
  - Design and Implement Bike Share Program
- Author, implement and report on Annual Bike/Ped Work Plan
  - o Develop measurables to track progress.
  - o Use GIS to organize, analyze and present information.
  - o Assess infrastructure needs
  - o Respond to citizen requests
  - o Create and run a Bike Rack Cost Share program w quarterly orders.
  - o Stay current on legislation associated with transportation
  - o Generate data on costs saved
- Coordinate and run Transportation Month, including
  - o Commissioner Walks
  - o Free Bus Day
  - o Green Commute Challenge
- Work within Department to further bike/ped goals
  - o Work with HARC to identify acceptable Bike Corrals and Corral areas
  - O Assist with consultant studies related to any of the above.
    - Assist with Walkable Duval program
- Increase coordination between departments by chairing TCT.
- Work strategically with the following departments to achieve shared goals.

# **Work with Code Compliance to:**

- Work with ADA Coordinator to fulfill legal responsibilities:
  - o Respond to ADA requests/complaints
  - o Maintain annual review and log of facilities compliance
  - o Design a proactive, holistic approach to Transition Plan
  - o Analyze street lighting & signalization for safer roadways.

### Work with Police Dept to:

- Investigate past and current bike/ped accidents implement safer solutions.
- Coordinate Enforcement Campaigns, including pre-education / outreach
- Audit and work with walking and biking tour groups to ensure compliance and safety.
- Audit and work with Bike Rental and Retail companies to ensure compliance and safety
- Hold / Publicize Bike Registration Events
- Hold / Publicize Bike Auctions
- Expand enforcement of speed limits

## Work with Engineering To:

- Guide spending of \$500,000 ADA money per year.
  - o Assess & upgrade sidewalks
  - o Prioritize list of improvements.
- Assess all bike lane markings, thermoplastic if needed.
- Increase traffic calming projects
- Review project plans

#### Work with KW DOT to:

- Get Tram Service off the ground
- Increase bus funding with Navy reimbursement program
- Increase bus funding by publicize employer/employee transit tax credits

# Work with Parking Manager to:

- Increase use of Park N Ride and other parking garages
- Increase Carpooling
- Develop block by block parking / bike racks layouts for commercial core.

#### **Work with Community to:**

- Maintain strong relationship with FDOT office to ensure future grants and opportunities.
- Provide leadership and assistance to Scenic Highway group.
- Work with largest employers to reduce VMTs.
- Work with Senior Center to increase mobility.
- Work with the County to increase safety of Stock Island workforce
- Work with School District & Other Youth Programs to:
  - o Run Safe Routes to School Programs
  - o Hold a Bike to School Day
  - o Host Bike Rodeos
- Work with FDOH & Other Health Programs to collaborate on walking and biking for health programs and events.
- Host, attend and/or assist various local, regional and state safety and advisory boards.
- Work with community groups to host classes and events to register bikes, teach bike safety, bike maintenance, and increase community involvement with biking and walking.
- Liaison with bike and running events.
- Create bicycle valet program for special events.
- Conduct focus groups and surveys to gauge support / ideas from community.
