

PROJECT BENEFITS


- Enhanced safety for pedestrians and drivers by providing a stop control condition at mid-block crossings.
- Improved vehicle traffic flow through the alternating red signal heads, which signals vehicles to proceed once the pedestrian has cleared the travel lane.
- Enhanced pedestrian nighttime visibility.

HOW IT WORKS


- The beacon remains dark for motorists until activated by a pedestrian push button.
- After activation, the motorist will see yellow light "flash" for a few seconds, followed by a steady yellow for a few seconds.
- A DOUBLE SOLID RED follows, requiring the driver to STOP at the stop bar. At this time, the pedestrian receives a WALK indication with a countdown timer. At the end of the WALK indication, the pedestrian is displayed a FLASHING DON'T WALK indication.
- The motorist sees a **DOUBLE FLASHING RED**. During this period, motorists are required to STOP or remain stopped until pedestrians have finished crossing the street, and then may proceed.









TYPICAL CROSS SECTION





PLAN VIEW




CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE











- Maintain business access during construction.
