WHEREAS, at the request of City staff, BA submitted the attached proposal for Work Authorization No. 1, Truman Waterfront Park Fruit Tree Garden, for design components, including concept sketch, preparation of construction drawings, plant design, selection, irrigation and security fencing, including Patrick Garvey/Grimal Grove, LLC in the design team to provide local knowledge relative to tree selection, soil suitability, siting and planting oversite; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NAVAL PROPERTIES LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

ACTION STATEMENT:

Approve a Work Authorization to Bermello Ajamil and Partners, Inc. for Truman Waterfront Park Fruit Tree Garden design and construction oversight in the amount of \$13,090.00 consistent with a recommendation from the Truman Waterfront Advisory Board. Approve necessary budget transfers.

BACKGROUND

Key West has a rich history of tropical fruit, a history that is nearly forgotten today. The early Key West settlers were a mix of Bahamians, Cubans and Anglos. The Cubans and Bahamians families, culturally different, had different preferred fruits and different culinary uses for fruit. As the cultures integrated, they formed an interesting and historically significant tropical fruit culture in Key West.

One of many Key West tropical fruit stories and a better known one is the mamey sapote. The one growing near a fire station in Key West is a prized cultivar. The seeds of this tree were believed to come from Cuba by way of 19th century dissidents who left the island at that time. The tree was originally called the Key West mamey sapote until it was selected and propagated by Eugenio Pantin in the early 1950s. The story goes that a Cuban émegré named Josefina Jimenez smuggled three mamey seeds into the US in her brassiere and gave them to Pantin, who grew them as seedling rootstocks, onto which he grafted budwood of the Key West mamey tree. Pantin then proceeded to plant a small commercial orchard in Miami-Dade County, Florida. This mamey is known throughout the tropical fruit world as the Pantin or Key West mamey.

At the March 20, 2017 meeting, the Truman Waterfront Advisory Board (TWAB) voted to recommend the Naval Properties Local Development Authority (LRA) approve siting a fruit grove at the Truman Waterfront Park (refer to attached TWAB meeting minutes). Following this direction, Engineering Services requested a proposal from Bermello Ajamil and Partners, Inc. (BA) to design and oversee construction/plantings of the fruit grove under their General Landscape Architectural Services agreement with the City (Resolution 12-221, extended through July 2017 by Resolution 15-209) and that BA add Patrick Garvey/Grimal Grove, LLC of Big Pine Key as a subconsultant. BA subsequently submitted a proposal for Work Authorization No. 1 Truman Waterfront Park Fruit Tree Garden dated April 11, 2017 (attached). The proposed fee of \$19,620. includes concept sketch, preparation of construction drawings and plant installation/construction oversight. Design components include, but are not limited to, landscape design, plant selection, irrigation and security fencing. Irrigation system will be designed to accommodate (by pipe schedule, depth) surface loading/impacts from vehicles, equipment or boat trailers.

Grimal Grove, LLC is included in the design team and will provide local knowledge relative to tree selection, soil suitability, siting and planting oversight. The grove is to be located at the southern end of the park as conceptually indicated on Page 1 of the BA proposal.

PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION

Truman Waterfront Park Fruit Tree Garden will distinguish Key West's little known tropical fruit history and is intended as a living museum. It will create a space for visitors and locals to learn, and enjoy the wonders of tropical fruit, as well as understand the edible vegetation used historically in Key West. The park will have a strong educational component, an excellent resource for local history and food education. It will be an asset in teaching our youth about nutrition, agriculture and preparing fruits. The park will also be a symbol for local food and will support agro-tourism in Key West.


FINANCIAL IMPACT:





Bermello Ajamil & Partners Inc. The Client has requested B&A to prepare construction drawings, which shall consist of fencing/gate plan and details; landscape plans including a Green Buttonwood windbreak and up to fifteen (15) tropical fruit trees; and an irrigation drip system connected to the Truman Waterfront Park mainline (located along the Park spine road). Knowing that the Park open space/lawn area will be used for event parking, the irrigation connection from the mainline shall be designed to be protected from damage due to vehicle loading/impacts.

The Client shall be responsible for electrical plan and electrical service to the site/area.

ACTION STATEMENT

Approving staff ranking of firms submitting responses to RFQ No. 12-002: General Landscape Architectural Services and authorizing City Manager to negotiate and pursuant to legal review enter into a contract.

BACKGROUND:

The City issued RFQ No. 12-002: General Landscape Architectural Services on April 1, 2012 and qualification packages were received on May 2, 2012. The City received the following ten (10) responses to the RFQ:

- Atkins
- Bermello Ajamil & Partners, Inc.
- Calle Verde
- Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc.
- Chen Moore
- EDSA
- Elizabeth Newland Landscape Architecture, LLC
- Hole Montes
- Landwise Design
- Savino & Miller Design Studio

Engineering staff reviewed each proposal to ensure the proposal contained the required submittals as well as contacted clients of each firm to check past work performances. Results are attached.

At a meeting held on June 14, 2012 a committee of City Staff met at a publicly

advertised meeting in order to review the 10 firms that responded.

Using the Selection Criteria Matrix in the RFQ, the selection committee developed a short list consisting of the following firms in highest to lowest ranking order:

- 1. EDSA
- 2. Bermello Ajamil & Partners, Inc
- 3. Savino & Miller Design Studio
- 4. Elizabeth Newland Landscape Architecture, LLC

All short-listed firms were highly recommended by past clients. Additionally all short-listed firms submitted proposals that were considered responsive to the RFQ. Elizabeth Newland Landscape Architecture, LLC failed to submit contact information from clients. However, City Staff has worked with this firm in the past and was satisfied with their work product.

As the City has multiple departments that manage projects of all sizes and disciplines simultaneously, the City typically prefers to contract with multiple firms to handle the workload. The term of contracts shall be for a period of three (3) years with the option of one (1) two (2) year renewal.

OPTIONS:

There are two (2) options:

- 1. Accept the rankings of staff and authorize City Manager to negotiate and pursuant to legal review enter into a contract with each of the short-listed firms,
- 2. Modify the staff's ranking and authorize City Manager to negotiate and pursuant to legal review enter into a contract with one or all of the firms of the modified ranking,

FINANCIAL ISSUES

There are no financial obligations with ranking and entering into contracts with each of the short-listed firms. These will be task order based contracts with which a dollar amount will have to be approved along with the task order per City Ordinance.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Commission accept the rankings of staff and authorize City Manager to negotiate and pursuant to legal review enter into a contract with each of the short-listed firms.
