A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO PASS LEGISLATION SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THAT CONTAINED INDIANA CODE TITLE 35-47-14-3, ATTACHED, WHICH ALLOWS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO SEIZE A FIREARM WITHOUT A WARRANT, UPON BELIEF THAT THE PERSON IS DANGEROUS; SUPPORTING MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT'S EFFORTS PROVIDE FOR Α SAFE **LEARNING** ENVIRONMENT: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in the wake of the tragic mass shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School last month, it is evident to the Key West City Commission that legislative action is necessary to protect public safety; and

WHEREAS, unfortunately, the Florida Legislature has preempted local control of firearms; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission calls upon state and national elected officials to enact gun control measures which will keep all residents, especially our children, safe; and

WHEREAS, the State of Indiana Code section 35-47-14-3 sets forth a law which allows a law enforcement officer (LEO) to seize a firearm from an individual whom the LEO believes to be dangerous without obtaining a warrant. After seizing the weapon, the law enforcement agency is required to submit a written statement under oath to a Court, describing the basis for seizing the weapon. A Judge would then be required to determine whether there is probable cause to retain the firearm; and

WHEREAS, the Key West City Commission finds that legislation substantially similar to the form of Indiana Code Section 35-47-14-3, would enhance the public safety of citizens in Key West and the state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission supports efforts by the Monroe County School District to ensure student safety, and encourages the participation of state and local agencies in order to provide necessary and valuable services to protect and support our children; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission stands ready to support our local school district in a concerted effort to keep our schools and community safe from violence. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission urges the Florida Legislature to pass legislation substantially similar to that contained in Indiana Code 35-47-14-3, attached.

Section 2: That the City Manager is directed to work cooperatively with the Key West Police Chief and Monroe County School District in any way that enhances the safety and security of our school children.

Section 3: That the City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Governor Rick Scott, Senate President Joe Negron, Senator Anitere Flores, House Speaker Corcoran, and Representative Holly Raschein.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
