A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF THE ONE PERCENT PUBLIC ART SET-ASIDE REQUIREMENT FOR THE BASILICA OF SAINT MARY STAR OF THE SEA ACTIVITY CENTER PROJECT, LOCATED AT 1010 WINDSOR LANE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-487(c)(1)c. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Basilica School of Saint Mary Star of the Sea, a non-profit educational facility, is constructing an activity center, and has submitted a request for a waiver of the Art in Public Places one percent Set Aside; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-487(c)(1)c. of the Code of Ordinances provides that certain **n**on-profits may have their public art fund set aside requirement waived, all or in part, by action of the city commission on a case by case basis upon a showing of a valid public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Basilica of Saint Mary Star of the Sea campus has long been a repository for significant historic and contemporary art, and the new Activity Center will serve a public purpose by providing activity space for students and community events; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that a waiver of the requirement for a one percent set-aside for public art at the Basilica of Saint Mary Star of the Sea School would serve a public purpose and directly benefit the residents of the City of Key West; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a waiver of the one percent public art set aside for the Basilica of Saint Mary Star of the Sea School Activity Center project is hereby authorized, pursuant to section 2-487(c)(1)c. of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
