## B. DOCUMENT INTERPRETATION

Should there be any doubt as to the meaning or intent of said Bid Documents, the Bidder should request of the Deputy Director Port and Marine Services, in writing (at least 4 calendar days prior to Bid opening) an interpretation thereof. Any interpretation or change in said Bid Documents will be made only in writing in the form of Addenda to the Documents, which will be furnished to all registered holders of Bid Documents. Bidders shall submit with their Bids, or indicate receipt of all Addenda. The Owner will not be responsible for any other explanation or interpretations of said Documents.

## 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Vendor shall provide necessary wiring, cabling, install, configure and test equipment and materials necessary to add security cameras, to include internet services and licenses to system. Cameras shall be installed in two locations as identified in the SUMMARY OF WORK

## 4. REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

The prospective Bidder must meet the statutorily prescribed requirements before award of Contract by the CITY. Bidders must hold or obtain all licenses and/or certificates as required by the State and Local Statutes in order to bid and provide the product specified herein. Additionally, all Bidders must meet the minimum qualifications as described in Required Qualifications section.

## 4. TYPE OF BID

#### UNIT PRICE BID

Bid unit prices stated in this proposal include all costs and expenses for labor, equipment, materials, disposal and contractor's overhead and profit. Unit prices for the various work items are intended to establish a total price for completing the project in its entirety. ## 5. PREPARATION OF BIDS
