Key West Transit – Making Connections

The Concept

The Key West Intermodal Center (KWIC) is but one idea that can help alleviate some of the issues faced by the Key West residents and visitors.

The KWIC would consist of several components: multi-level automobile and bus parking structure; Key West Transit hub offering connections to city routes and the Lower Keys Shuttle; Connections to commercial coach services; ferry boat service to Key West Ferry Terminal; and sports field

If the project is accepted and funded, the KWIC would provide connectivity via various modes of transportation such as public and private motor vehicles, bicycles, and ferry boat to the local area.

Key West Transit – Making Connections

The Way Ahead

Include in City of Key West Capital Improvement Plan

Include in next year's Transit Development Plan (Information from TDP can support the grant requirements)

Develop grant packet for the Federal Transit Agency which includes:

- purpose and need (P & N -- what are your trying to solve)
- locally preferred alternative (evaluated several and selected one based on the P & N)
- site plan and alternatives
- NEPA Class of Action
- capital budget, funding plan and perhaps a traffic study (and this usually comprises feasibility).

Develop grant packet for Florida Department of Environmental Protection: Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program
