A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING THE AWARD OF A THREE YEAR CONTRACT FOR HOLIDAY LIGHTING TO BRANDANO DISPLAYS, INC. IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. ADDITIONAL 005-18 AND NEGOTIATED AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH TERMS CONTAINED IN RFP 005-18, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFER(S); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, one proposal was received in response to RFP 05-18, and after a presentation and discussion before the Bight Board in May 2018, and further negotiations with staff, the vendor agreed to a significant discount on the original base bid, along with alternates; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 13, 2018, the Key West Bight Management District Board considered the negotiated proposal, and recommended that the CRA award a contract to Brandano Displays, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a three-year contract with Brandano Displays, Inc. in a first-year amount not to exceed \$59,827.00, with CPI adjustments and additive or deductive alternates to be determined for the two following years, in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Request for Proposal # 005-18 and amendments thereto, and with the CRA's final approved budget or approved budget amendment.

Section 2: That a budget transfer from Key West Historic Seaport Reserves to account 405-7504-575-4800, promotional expenses, in the amount of \$30,000.00 is hereby approved in FY 17-18. Additional funds will be budgeted in FY 18-19.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with documents contained in RFP 005-18, inclusive of negotiated amendments, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
