A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE THE FEASIBILITY OF UTILIZING THE HISTORIC DIESEL ENERGY PLANT AT 100 ANGELA STREET/GERALDINE STREET AS A MUSEUM FOR THE WORLD POWERBOAT FOUNDATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The City has been approached by the World Powerboat Foundation with interest in utilizing the historic diesel energy plant at 100 Angela Street/Geraldine Street for a museum; and

WHEREAS, Any such proposal shall be reviewed by the Bahama Village Redevelopment Advisory Committee and any other necessary City Boards or Commissions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Resolution directing the City Manager to pursue the feasibility of utilizing the historic diesel energy plant at 100 Angela Street/Geraldine Street as a museum for the World Powerboat Foundation is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
