Key to the Caribbean - Average yearly temperature 77°

The City currently has an agreement with KEYS Energy Services, Inc. (KEYS) for maintenance and periodic inspection of traffic signals. The KEYS agreement is consistent with the new FDOT *Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement*. The average cost to the City for these services has historically been below the scheduled FDOT compensation. Compensation is managed in Account 102-0000-369-0000 and KEYS maintenance costs are managed in Account 102-4102-541-4601.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends amending the 2017-2018 Exhibit A to the Florida Department of Transportation Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement, Contract No. ARU46 and authorizing the City Manager to execute the Exhibit.
