SUBJECT: Approval of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Key West and Monroe County for the City to oversee the scheduling of the use of the sports fields at Bernstein Park for the various sports entities and athletic leagues.

ACTION STATEMENT: Approve the Interlocal agreement between the City of Key West and Monroe County regarding scheduling of Bernstein Park.

BACKGROUND:

Bernstein Park has undergone major renovations and there are now multiple athletic fields as well as a baseball/softball diamond. Now that it is nearing completion the athletic leagues will need to be scheduled for the use of the fields.

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION:

The City of Key West already does the scheduling of athletic fields within the City for use by the various sports leagues. Many of the leagues participants are Monroe county residents from up the Keys. Due to this fact the City and County thought it would be a good idea to have the City also schedule the athletic leagues at Bernstein Park.

The times that the City would be scheduling for leagues at Bernstein Park are: Monday - Friday 5:00 pm until 10:00 pm close.

Saturday 8:00 am until 3:00 pm close.

The City would also oversee some training and assistance with maintenance of the field.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Besides employee time scheduling and assistance with training/maintenance there is no financial impact on the City.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approving the Interlocal agreement between the City of Key West and Monroe County.
