Key West Art in Public Places

In 2008 Historic Markers, Incorporated built and donated the art improvements to Gato Park located at 616 Louisa Street. The improvements are currently part of the city artwork collection on display to the public. The Gato art pieces consist of:

- A sculptural façade of a Gatoville cottage that once stood on the park property.
- A 13 foot cigar sculpture that AIPP recently helped restore.
- A metal rooster on the cottage roof.
- A metal cat sitting in the window of the cottage.

The cigar cottage sculpture was never completed before its donation in 2008. The facade was originally designed with:

- A fixed mount, rusticated, wood door.
- Historic Markers, Inc. chose Rick Worth to paint a mural depiction of a husband and wife that lived in the cigar maker's cottage.

Historic Markers, Inc. will build the door using rough cut lumber to replicate the rest of the sculpture. They will install the door prior to Rick Worth's painting.

The cost of this art project is:

- Rick Worth mural painting - \$600.00.
- Wood for the door - \$400.00.
- Historic Markers door construction and installation - \$200.00.
