# Community Aesthetic Feature

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## What is a CAF:

- Enhancements installed on the SHS or Interstate
- Purpose is to represent, reflect or recognize:
  - ✓ Nearby community cultural and/or natural values and resources
  - ✓ Enhance the sense of place

# Community Aesthetic Feature (cont.)

- Designed, maintained and paid for by the local governmental entity.
- May be constructed by the local governmental entity or as part of a Department project.

# Criteria

- No parking
- No signs (**MUTCD** Part 1, Chap.1A.13)
- No commercial advertising
- Lighting allowed
- No median interstate installations
- One Stand-Alone feature per mainline interchange approach allowed





# Criteria (cont.)

- Limited Access right-of-way: must not be visible from the mainline
- Meet all applicable building codes and design criteria
- No obstruction to signs, sight distance, sight triangles, or view zones
- No adverse environmental impacts
- Signed and sealed final plans
- ***Exhibit 23-A*** signed by applicant and DDE

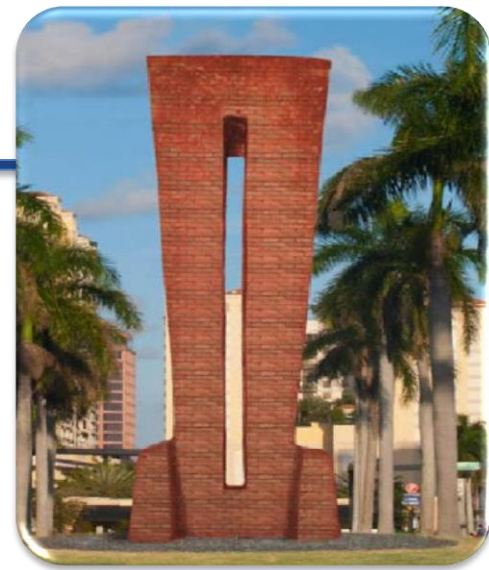

- Height  $\leq 25'$

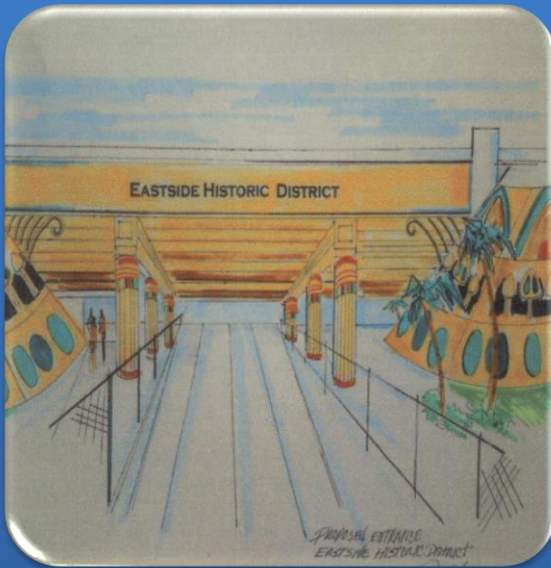

  - Curb & gutter  $\leq 45\text{mph}$
  - Restricted ROW
  - 6' from edge of inside travel lane

# Public Art

## Public Art – Add-On/Affixed



- No messages, words or alphanumeric characters
- Artist insignia
- Must not reduce vertical clearance

# Local ID Marker – Stand Alone

- Outside the clear zone
- Name of municipality, county, or community area
- Short phrase or message allowed
- Height  $\leq 25'$



## Interstates

- 50' min.  
(100' preferred)
- Letter height  $\leq 4'$

## Urban Roadways

- Median:
  - Design Speed  $\leq 45\text{mph}$
  - Curb & gutter
  - Restricted ROW
  - 6' from edge of inside travel lane

# Local Identification Marker

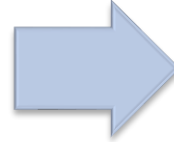
## Local ID Marker – Add-On/Affixed

- Name of municipality, county or community area
- Short phrase or message
- Must not reduced vertical clearance
- Interstates:
  - Letter height  $\leq 4'$
  - No phrase or message

- Required for CAFs installed on FDOT ROW.
- Provides for design, construction, maintenance and bonding of the CAF.

This Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, between the State of Florida, Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the \_\_\_\_\_ ("Party"). FDOT and the Agency are sometimes referred to in this Agreement as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

The Agency has requested permission from FDOT to install a [CHOOSE ONE: ☐ Public Art – Standalone, ☐ Local Identification Marker – Standalone, ☐ Public Art – Add On/affixed, ☐ Local Identification Marker – Add On/affixed] community aesthetic feature on that certain right-of-way owned by FDOT which is located at \_\_\_\_\_ County, Florida ("Project").

FDOT agrees that transportation facilities enhanced by community aesthetic features can benefit the public, result in positive economic development, and increase tourism both locally and throughout Florida.

C. The Parties agree to the installation and maintenance of the Project, subject to the terms and conditions in this Agreement.

**1. TERM.** The term of this Agreement shall commence upon full execution of this Agreement ("Effective Date") and continue through \_\_\_\_\_, which is determined as the lifespan of the Project, unless terminated at an earlier date as provided in this Agreement. If the Agency does not complete the installation of the Project within \_\_\_\_\_ days of the Effective Date of this Agreement, FDOT may immediately terminate this Agreement. This Agreement may only be renewed for a term no longer than the original term of this Agreement upon a writing executed by both Parties to this Agreement.

**2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION.** The Project is a [CHOOSE ONE: ☐ Public Art – Standalone, ☐ Public Art – Add On/affixed, ☐ Local Identification Marker – Standalone, ☐ Local Identification Marker – Add On/affixed], as more fully described in the plans in Exhibit "A", attached and incorporated in this Agreement.

- Agreement between the local governmental entity and FDOT.
  - ✓ Form 625-010-10
  - ✓ Director of Transportation Development or District Secretary (or delegate), after a review by the District General Counsel's Office

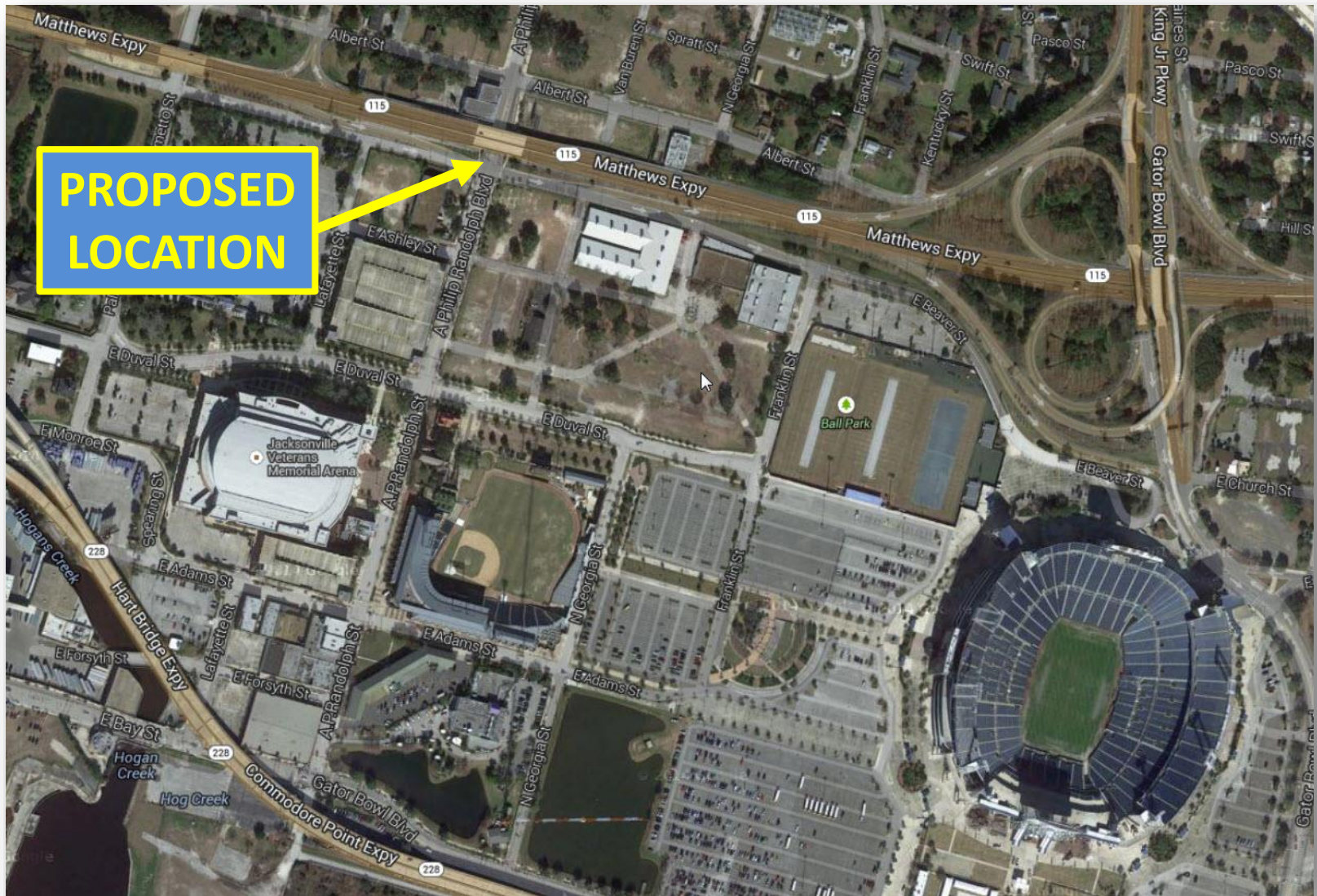

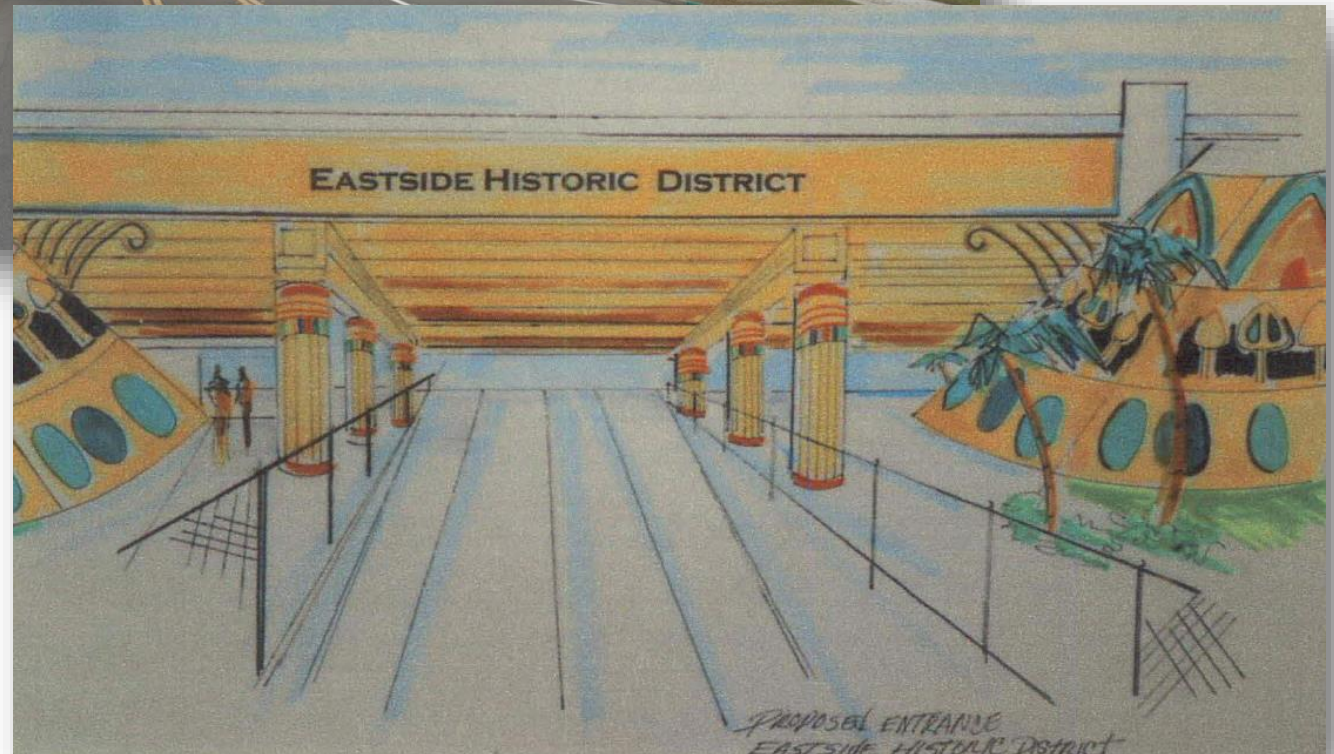

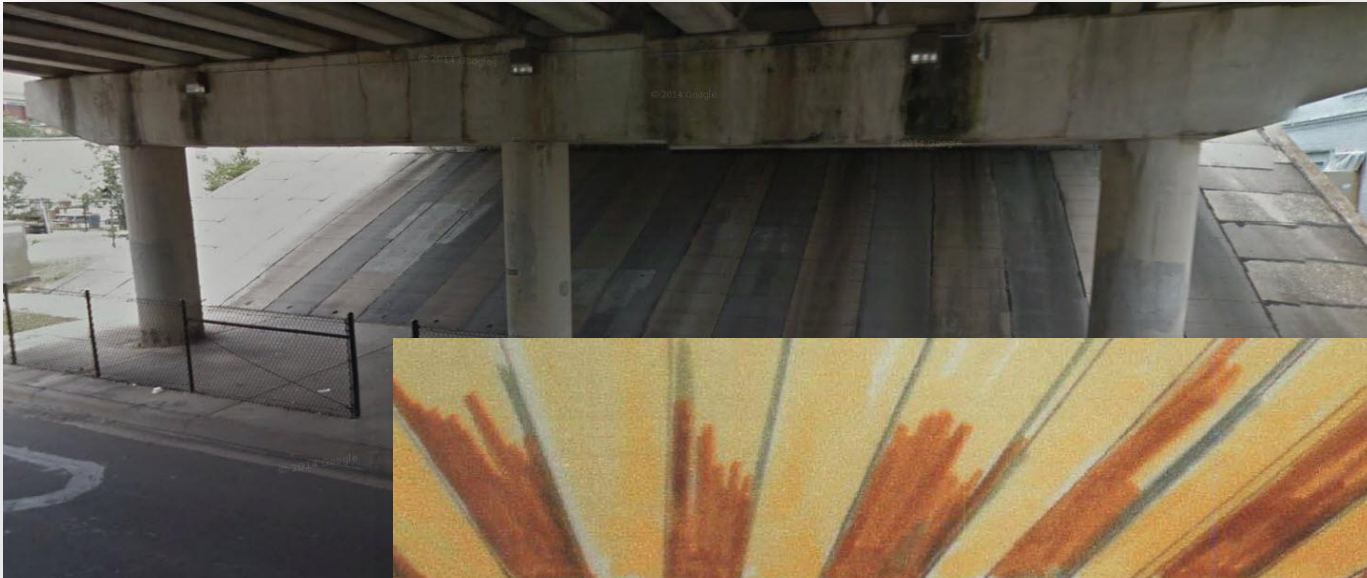

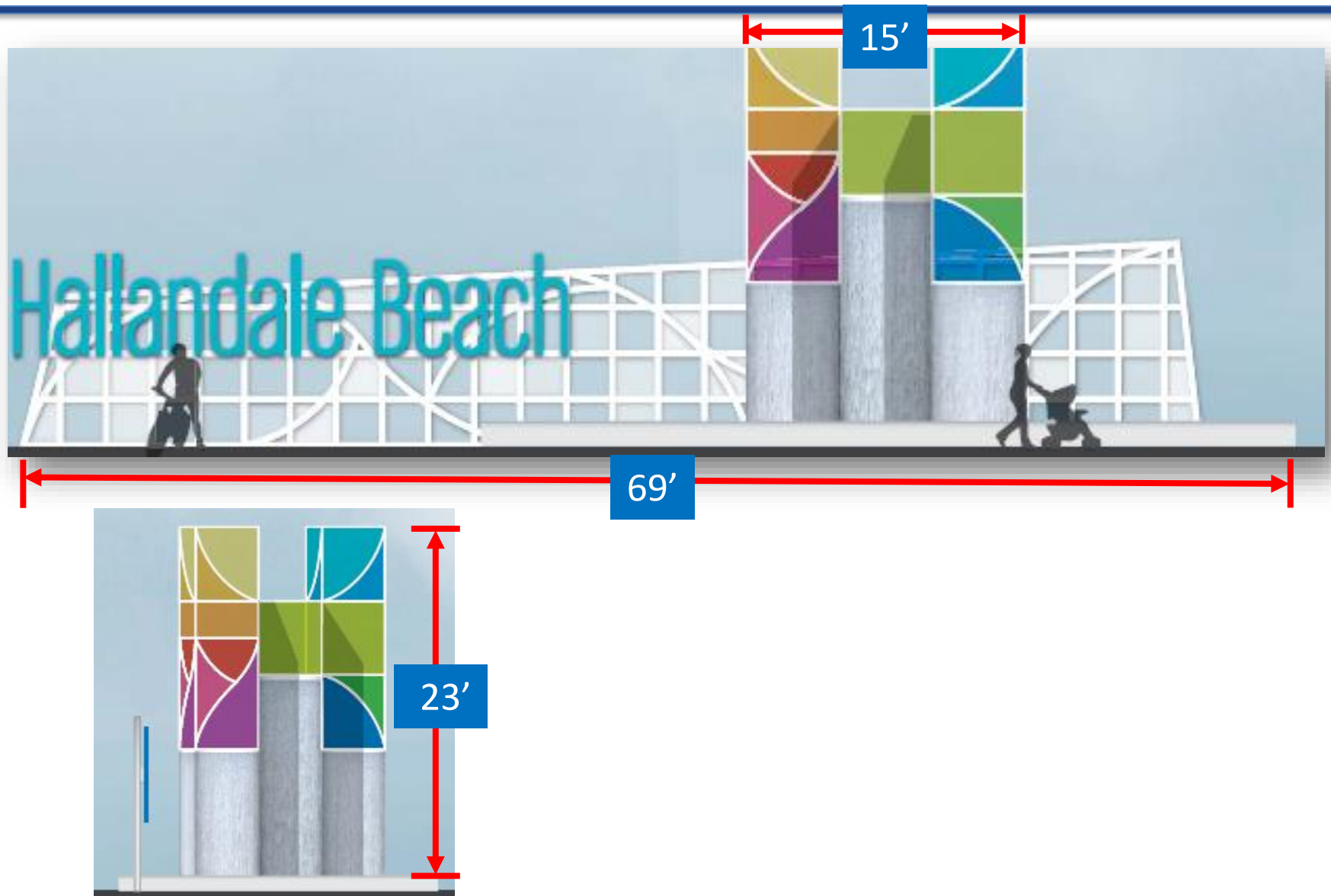

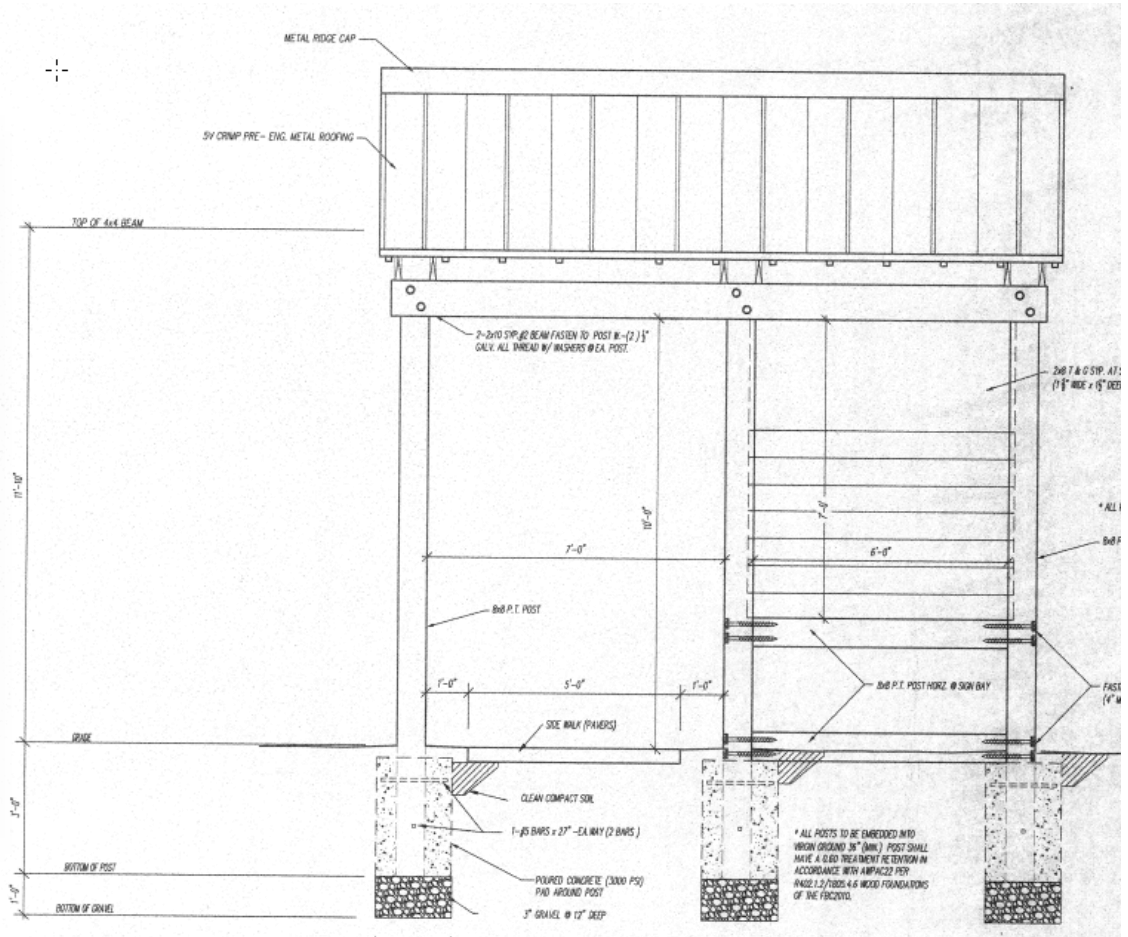

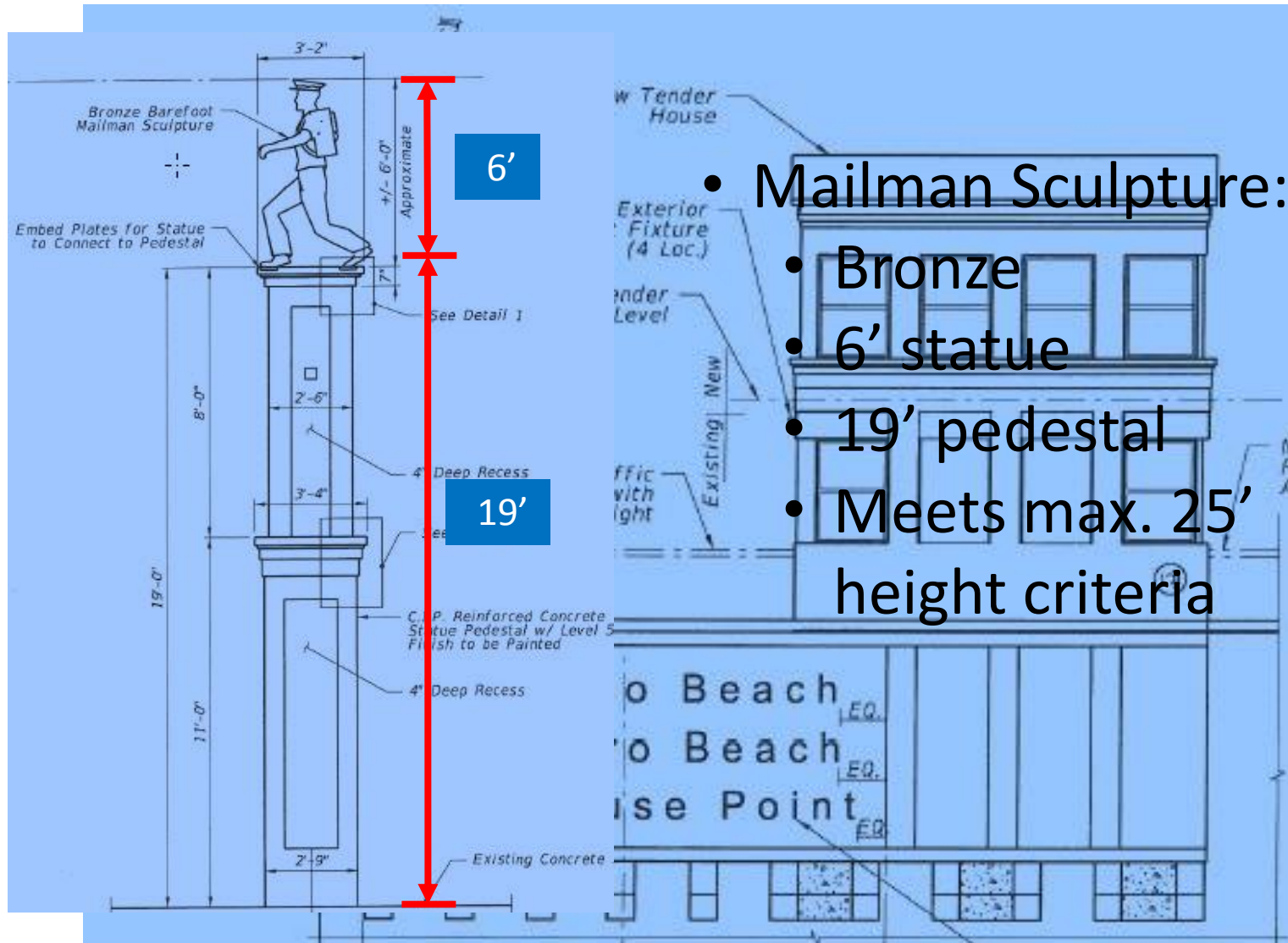

# Frequently Asked Questions

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## **1. How are the maintenance related requirements for a Community Aesthetic Feature (CAF) installation documented?**

The Community Aesthetic Feature (CAF) Agreement includes standardized language for maintenance.



# Frequently Asked Questions

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## **2. Which office will administer the CAF review and approval process?**

The District Design Office and the State Roadway Design Office along with the Roadway Aesthetics Community of Practice.

# Frequently Asked Questions

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## **3. What role does the Roadway Aesthetics Community of Practice (RA CoP) have in the CAF approval process?**

The purpose of the review by the RA CoP is to ensure statewide consistency for the varieties of CAFs approved to be installed on FDOT right of ways.

# Frequently Asked Questions

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## **4. Do the requirements for CAFs proposed to be installed on “Interstate” facilities also apply to “Limited Access” facilities which are not on the Interstate System?**

Any CAFs proposed on a Limited Access facility will be required to abide by Interstate design criteria and require FHWA approval.

# Frequently Asked Questions

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**5. Is a permit needed for the Local Governmental Entity to perform future planned/required maintenance work on an approved CAF installation?**

No. The executed CAF Agreement provides the necessary authority/approval for the Local Governmental Entity to do all construction and maintenance work.

# Frequently Asked Questions

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## **6. How is the appropriate and necessary dollar amount determined for the required bond or deposit?**

A bond (or letter of credit) or deposit is required to cover the cost to remove the CAF installation and restore the site to pre-construction conditions.
