# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**SUBJECT:** Rejection of Bids: ITB #18-035 – Surveillance System

### **ACTION STATEMENT**

Resolution rejecting bids for ITB #18-035 – Road Surveillance and Monitoring Duval Street, Mallory Square & Outer Mole.

### **BACKGROUND**

Duval Street is heavily populated with visitors and locals throughout most of the year. In an effort to provide extra security measures, the Police Department has requested the installation of security cameras at the densest populated areas of Duval Street.

Also, as part of the Coast Guard security requirements for Cruise Ships we must continuously monitor Mallory Square and Outer Mole/Truman Waterfront cruise ship security checkpoints. Both facilities have been cited by the Coast Guard for failing to continuously monitor the restricted areas within the facilities as required by 33CFR105.275.

The Mallory Square and Outer Mole portion of this project has been bid and rejected two times prior through Resolutions #18-093 and 18-142. In an attempt to get the Mallory Square and Outer Mole projects completed, Seaport staff coordinated with the City's IT Department to combine all three projects into one bid package.

### **PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION**

ITB #18-035 was advertised and bids received from three vendors on July 19, 2018 as follows:

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PSX, Inc.	Bid:	\$ 89,708.17
Broadwave, LLC	Bid:	\$ 159,287.40
IFSSI	Bid:	\$ 232,947.72

Staff has reviewed the proposals and determined that none of the Bidders provided a proposal to include a 100% self-healing, redundant fluid mesh monitoring system along Duval Street or the required video monitoring for the Outer Mole Pier.

Pursuant to Section 2-834(3) and (4) of the Code of Ordinances the City may reject bids if the bid or proposal is not responsive, not properly delivered, not properly signed or is unsigned, shows serious omissions, alterations in form, additions not called for, conditions or unauthorized alterations, or irregularities of any kind and/or if staff determines that acceptance of a bid is not in the best interest of the city including budgetary reasons. Port and IT staff are investigating other possibilities for the completion of this needed work.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

There is no financial impact associated with rejection of this bid.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends rejection of bids for ITB #18-035 – Road Surveillance and Monitoring Duval Street, Mallory Square & Outer Mole pursuant to Section 2-834(3) and (4) of the Code of Ordinances

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
