BACKGROUND

As part of the Coast Guard security requirements for Cruise Ships we must continuously monitor Mallory Square and Outer Mole/Truman Waterfront cruise ship security checkpoints. Both facilities have been cited by the Coast Guard for failing to continuously monitor the restricted areas within the facilities as required by 33CFR105.275.
