AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF \mathtt{THE} CODE ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "RESOURCE PROTECTION" BY AMENDING ARTICLE VI ENTITLED PROTECTION", SECTION 110-331 TITLED "ISSUANCE", TO PROVIDE FOR UNFULFILLED TREE REMOVAL PERMITS TO BE FORWARDED TO THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West finds that fulfilling the replacement inches of approved tree removal permits are critical to the promotion of the tree canopy within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West finds that ensuring the replanting of trees that are required as part of a tree removal permit can best be served by referring unfulfilled permits to the special magistrate for enforcement hearings; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Board for the City of Key West approved this ordinance revision at their meeting of July 19th, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 110-331 of the Code of
Ordinances is hereby amended as follows*:

Sec. 110-331. - Issuance.

(4) If a permit holder fails to fulfill the terms of the tree removal permit as provided in chapter 110, article VI, division 3, the Tree Commission shall forward the case to the code enforcement special master for further hearing and penalty.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said
City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby
superseded to the extent of such conflict.
