








Turkey Point Update


Saltwater Front

Proposed Remediation

- Extract hypersaline water
- Inject into the Boulder Zone



Next Steps

- Obtain and analyze data
- Determine next course of action



Additional Issues

- Proposed facility expansion
- Proposed extension of CCS permits
- FDEP Permit Modification to lower elevations at freshwater structures.
