A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) UNDER THE "HELPING EMERGENCY RESPONDERS OBTAIN SUPPORT (HEROS)" GRANT PROGRAM, FOR EMERGENCY OPIOID ANTAGONIST/NARCAN DOSES; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Key West Fire Department submitted an online application to the DOH HEROS program, for doses of emergency opioid antagonist/NARCAN, that would otherwise be paid for by the Department; and

WHEREAS, the DOH HEROS grant award will provide the Fire Department with doses of this essential medication in various forms and quantities, including intranasal, fixed needle and Luer Lock doses, resulting in potential cost saving of up to \$36,577.80 for the department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

Section 1.: The City Commission hereby approves and accepts the DOH HEROS program award for emergency opioid antagonist/Narcan doses.

Section 2: That any necessary budget transfers are approved.
